

Grain Futures Move Higher

CHICAGO, June 17 (AP)—Prices of grain futures moved sharply higher on the board of trade today as active buying spread to all pits.

Influenced by unfavorable weather and a new loan rate for wheat, all grains were strong at the opening and commercial interests found offerings in the wheat pit limited by announcement of the government allocations for August for export wheat.

Another government factor was an interim wheat loan announcement of \$1.80 per bushel on a national average, equivalent to \$3.05 at Chicago, pending establishment of official rates to be determined later.

NEW YORK, June 17 (AP)—Stocks found no urgency among either buyers or sellers in today's market. Activity in the neighborhood of 800,000 shares made it the lightest session in about a week.

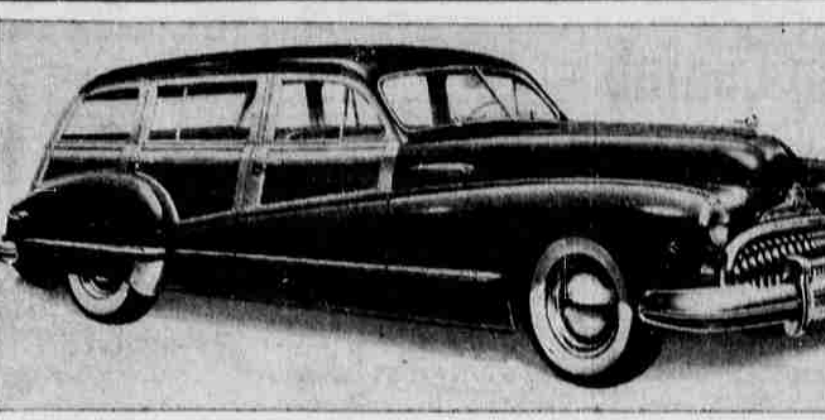
