Government Gets Oil Land

WASHINGTON, June 23 (AP)—The supreme court today upheld the federal government's claim to ownership of oil-rich submerged lands off the California coast.

The United States contended it had title to a belt beginning at low tide and extending seaward three miles.

California claimed ownership of the land, on which it has issued about 100 leases for withdrawal of oil by various companies.

The oil and other mineral deposits at stake in the litigation were believed to be worth many billions.

Justice Black delivered the court's 4-2 decision.

Ellsworth Attacks Political Motives In Truman Tax Veto

WASHINGTON, June 23 (AP)—Rep. Ellsworth (R-Ore.) said today that President Truman vetoed the tax reduction bill "for purely political reasons" and because of it, taxpayers will pay 20 to 30 per cent more taxes next year.

"In vetoing the tax reduction bill," Ellsworth said in a statement, "the president used many words, but the truth of the matter is the president wants tax reduction to take place next year when he is running for re-election."

E. P. Ivory of the Ivory Pine Mills Saturday announced his firm as high bidder on a tract of some 90,000,000 feet of virgin pine and fir known as the Ten Mile timber sale unit of the Sequoia national forest located east of Fresno, Calif. This is United States forest service territory.

Ivory said the bid totaled approximately \$78,000. This is the firm's first holdings in the area and plans for a mill are not completed but are to be projected within the next 12 months, Ivory said this afternoon.

Bids on the tract were opened by the regional forester in San Francisco at 2 p.m. Friday.
