

Senator Pepper Sees Boost For Third Party Move In Labor Bill Veto Action; GOP May Lose Organized Labor's Vote

WASHINGTON, June 24 (AP)—Enactment of the Taft-Hartley labor law over President Truman's veto brought disputed predictions today of a third party movement and possible republican loss of the organized labor vote.

Senator Pepper (D-Fla.) told a reporter he thinks "tremendous impetus" was given the fledgling third party movement by the senate's 68 to 25 vote yesterday smothering Mr. Truman's veto.

"Political history has been written here," Pepper declared. "Congress has done more than Henry Wallace ever did to give a lift to a third party."

No Majority

"We have seen a demonstration that neither party can muster a majority in congress for liberal proposals."

"Nobody but intellectual liberals

has been interested in a third party up to now, but if the working people feel that their rights aren't going to be protected they may make a third party movement a vital affair."

Pepper, one of 22 democrats who voted to sustain the president's veto, said he will remain a democrat in any event.

Senator Byrd (D-Va.) one of the 20 democrats who cash their ballots against the veto, said he thinks the president has succeeded in making at least the administration's part of the democratic party the labor party for 1948.

Byrd, who had urged the president to sign the bill, noted that Mr. Truman pulled only a slim majority of the senate democrats along with him on the issue. The president got only minority support from his own party when the house overrode the veto last Friday by a vote of 331 to 83.

Political Effect

There was a dispute about the political effect of the vote on the republicans, too.

Senator Aiken (R-Vt.) told a reporter that "as of today I think the republican party has lost the rank and file labor vote."

"It has a chance to recover some of it if it will act in the next congress to amend some of the law's objectionable features before the 1948 election," Aiken added.

The Vermont senator said that on the strength of promises from party leaders that such amendments would be undertaken, he voted to override the president's veto.

Solon Fights Oil Decision

WASHINGTON, June 24 (AP)—Rep. Poulson (R-Calif.) asserted Monday that he will begin immediately the preparation of a bill to surrender the federal government's interest in the tidelands to the states.

"It will be a bill that congress will pass over the president's veto and which the supreme court will understand," Poulson told a reporter after the supreme court had ruled against California in the tidelands ownership controversy.

Poulson said his bill would provide a federal quitclaim in favor of the states of the tidelands, submerged lands and lands beneath beds of bays, lakes and other navigable waters.

Earlier Rep. Bradley (R-Calif.) predicted such legislation would be introduced "very quickly."

Congress passed such a quitclaim bill last year, but it was vetoed by President Truman. The veto was sustained in congress.

Senator Downey (D-Calif.) also told a reporter that congress should "go ahead with legislation to secure a quitclaim."

"The supreme court decision does not affect the equities of the situation, but merely is a statement of the naked legal principles," he said.

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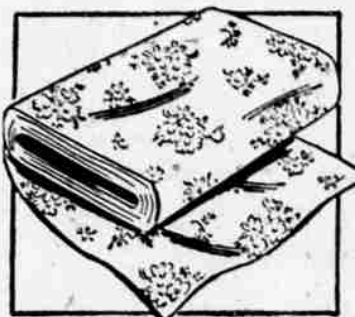
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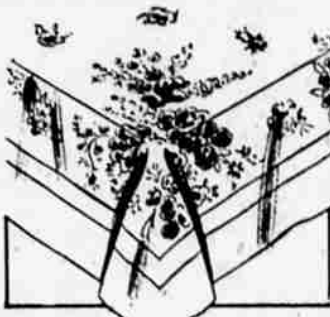
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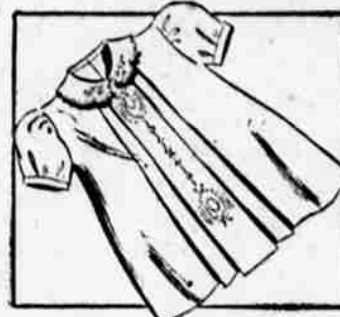
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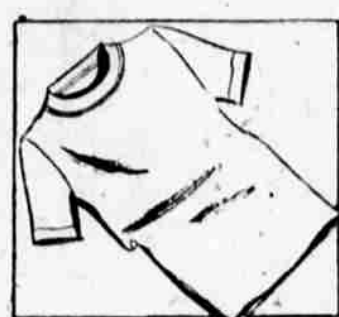
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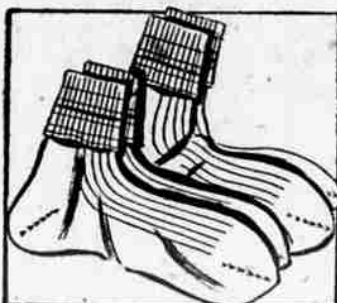
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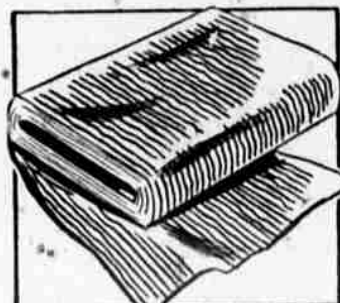
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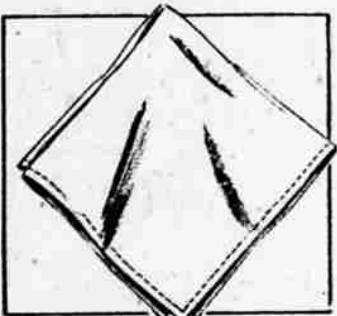
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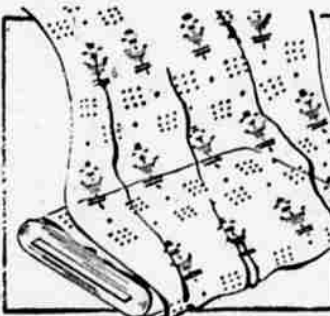
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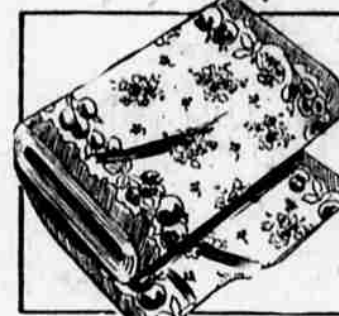
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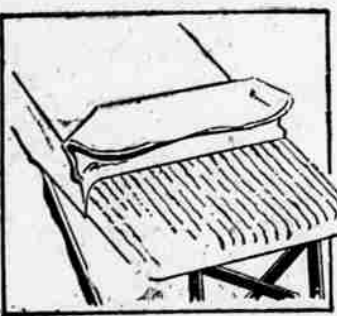
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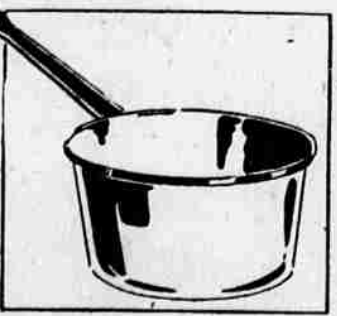
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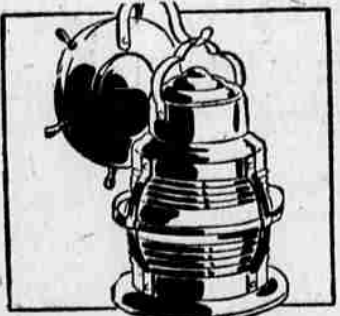
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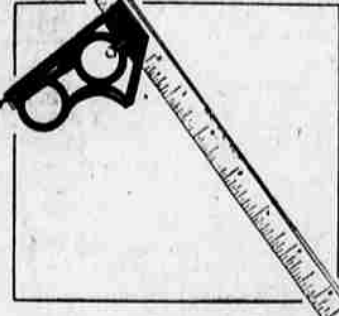
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
