

Copco President Tells Of Sale Of Common Stock

According to advice just received from A. S. Cummins, president of the California Oregon Power company, Standard Gas and Electric company, one of the nation's fore-

most public utility holding companies, and the owner of all of the outstanding common stock of the California Oregon Power company, today sold its entire holdings of such

stock to a group of investment bankers headed jointly by Blyth and company, Inc. and First Boston corporation, both of New York City. This sale by Standard Gas and Electric company was in compliance with an earlier order of the securities and exchange commission, an agency of the federal government, requiring the liquidation of that company. Previously Standard Gas

and Electric company had disposed of its interest in the following other West coast companies: San Diego Gas and Electric company, Pacific Gas and Electric company and Mountain States Power company. Cummins states that a public offering of this common stock, together with 18,000 shares to be sold by the company, will be made by the underwriting group on Tuesday,

June 24, at \$22.25 per share. He points out that with the consummation of the sale by Standard Gas and Electric company, the California Oregon Power company will be 100 per cent investor owned, with no interest or group owning a majority of its stock. Cummins said that this change is expected to have no effect upon the company's organization or its operating policy.

Cummins further announced that the California Oregon Power company has indefinitely postponed its proposed plan to call for payment of its outstanding 6 per cent preferred stock, and that the directors yesterday declared the regular quarterly dividend on its preferred stocks payable July 15 to stockholders of record June 30. Cummins states that the under-

writing group which purchased the common stock has informed him they intend to reserve a certain amount of the issue for territory distribution and suggests that local residents wishing to subscribe should contact their local bank of investment dealers for particulars.
