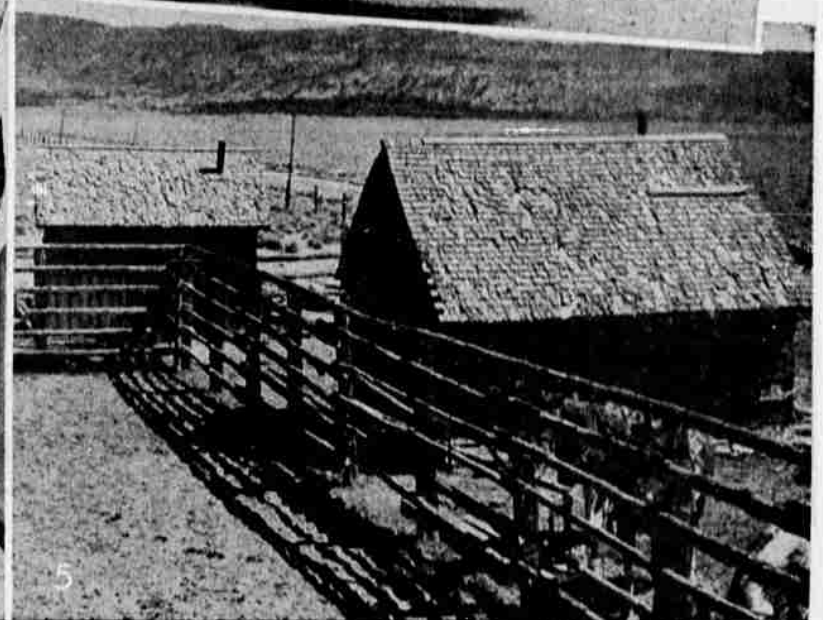
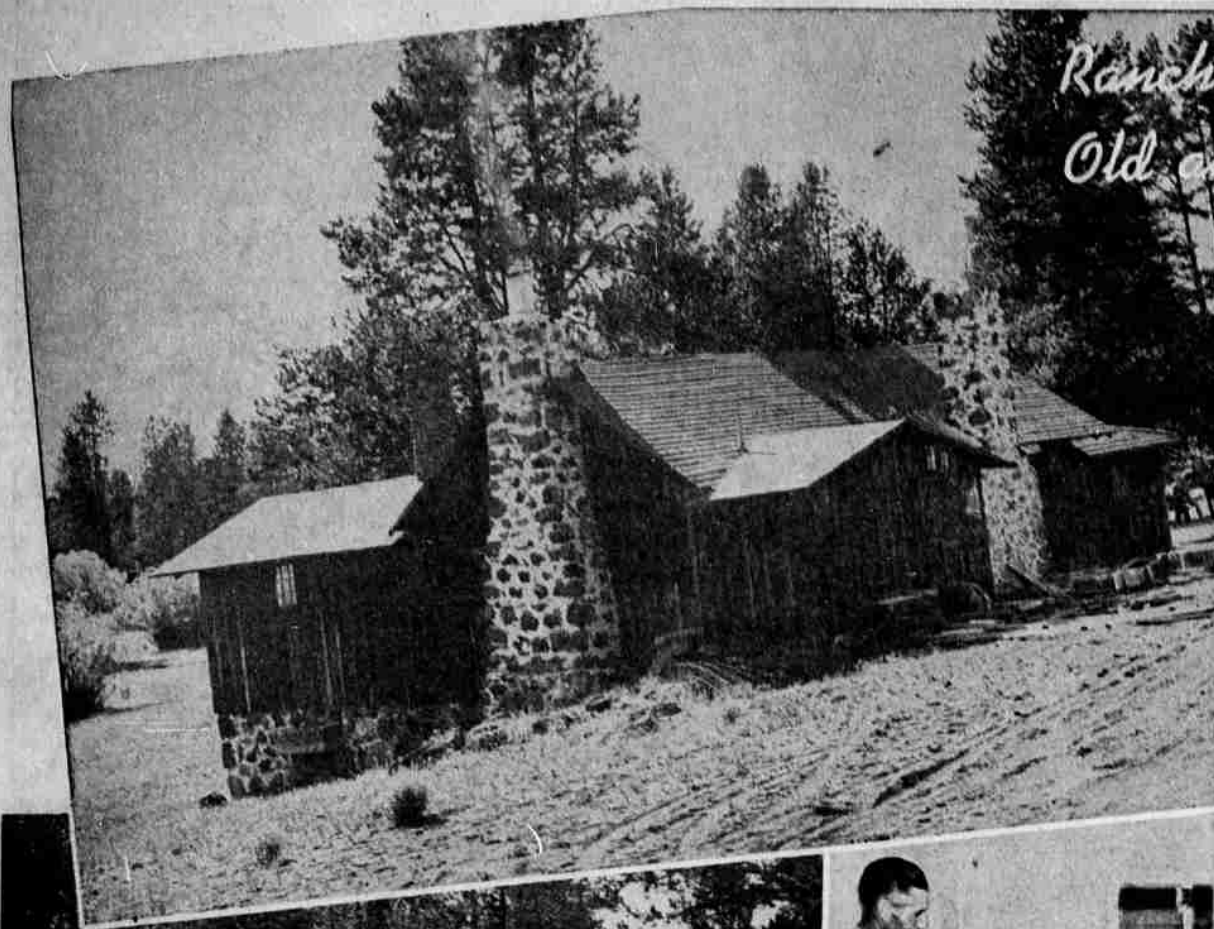


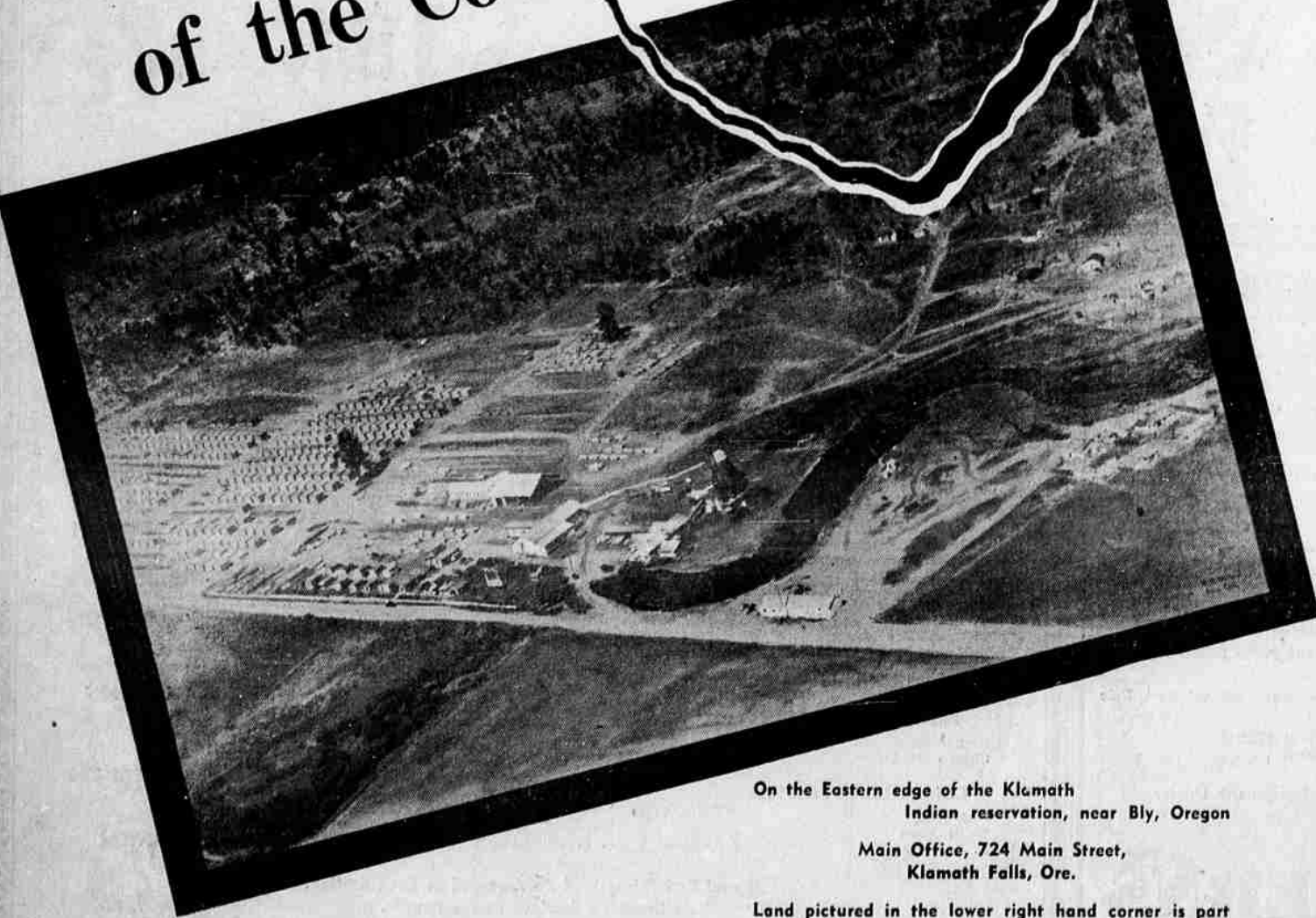
*Ranch Life...

WHEN CATTLEMEN FIRST CAME into the Klamath country they found plenty of pine to cut down to fashion their homes. Some of the old places still stand. 1. Cookhouse on the Bar-Y ranch in the Yamsay country northeast of Chiloquin. 2. Handsome W. C. Dalton home on the Carr ranch just over the California-Oregon line. It stands on the site of the original house built long before the turn of the century by Jesse D. Carr, founder of the holdings. 3. An example of log structure found in the old tool house on the Bar-Y. 4. Modern note at the Dalton ranch where hands wash up in the new bunk house.
