The architectural motif gives the feeling of space and elegance and at the same time an atmosphere of intimacy and romance, with brilliant colors used throughout the room to emphasize these qualities with a subtle force. The name Tocatee Terrace was chosen for its depth of meaning and its connection with the early tradition of the Klamath-Modoc country. The word TOCATEE is combined from four Indian words, TOK, TOKE, TU KATEE, which mean, broadly interpreted, a meeting place for dining and dancing, and friendly talk by the river, waterfalls, lakes and mountain country.

From the time you enter the foyer where the beautiful reflection pool picks up from walls and ceiling the swirling colors of the decor until you enter the main room where your eye is caught by the huge mural along the southern wall you will be delighted by the manner in which the architect and the artist have caught the mood of this country. The rich and gleaming colors of the room catch the same brilliancy and splendor as that seen throughout the whole magnificent Cascade Wonderland.

The Tocatee mural depicts the sparkling hues of the Oregon-California country in an arabesque of pattern symbolizing the mountains and lava cliffs with mauve and purple, rose and tan, the verdure with its yellow and chartreuse, gold and blue-green, the turquoise waterfall and the azure sky where all the colors of the rainbow glisten in reflection.
