Grocery stores, the post office and some restaurants will close for the one day, the Fourth of July. The Herald and News will publish on the 4th and there will be no paper the 5th or 6th.

Local Dairy Finishes Extensive Remodeling

The Lost River Dairy, through its manager, R. C. Woodruff, announces that with the installation of a Sealright bottle filler the plant has completed its extensive remodeling and improvement program which has been under way for over a year. The plant is now equipped with the finest and most modern milk processing equipment manufactured.

The Sealright filler places a sterilized hood over the entire pouring lip of the bottle in addition to the regular cap, giving the milk double protection until it is poured from the container in the kitchen. Medical men and public health authorities have long recognized that dirt, possibly germs, may adhere to the pouring rim of the bottle and be transferred to the milk in pouring. The Sealright hood on bottles prevents this possibility, Woodruff said.

Other new equipment installed includes the Cherry-Burrell Shortline pasteurizer and Chicago bottle filler capable of pasteurizing and bottling

48 quarts of milk per minute. The Cherry-Burrell Shortline pasteurizer automatically heats every particle of milk to a temperature of 161 degrees for 16 seconds and cools it down to a temperature of 40 degrees almost instantaneously. Pasteurization at this high temperature and cooling immediately is the only certain method of absolute pasteurization without possibility of injuring the delicate flavor of milk, Woodruff stated.

In April the installation of a Flowmaster Homogenizer was completed. This is used in processing the two new products just introduced, Medo-Rich Homogenized milk and Creamore. Medo-Rich and Creamore are run through the homogenizer under extremely high pressure which breaks up every small particle of curd and fat into as many as 100 smaller particles and these smaller particles are suspended throughout the milk.

Woodruff extended an invitation to visit this fine new plant and see it in operation.

Swan Lake To Be Logged

Logging in the Swan lake country will be started after the Fourth by Puckett and Scherer, operators of the new sawmill at Keno.

The company has been logging on the Pokemona district, sawing a part of its logs at Keno and selling the others to Klamath Falls operators. A part of the logs from Swan lake will also go onto the log market here.

Swan lake country was generally logged for pine years ago, but there is a considerable stand of valuable fir in the area which will be taken in the new cut.

The mill on Klamath river at Keno is sawing an average of about 25,000 feet a shift, but at top capacity can make 40,000 feet a shift.
