

# Hotel Guests Jolted By Hike In Prices; Some Eviction Notices Posted

Permanent residents in many hotels throughout the nation have received notices their rents are to be increased—ranging upward from 15 per cent.

Although a boost of 15 per cent was the most frequently reported as the hotels were freed from controls under the new federal rent law there were instances of rent increases as much as from 25 to 45 per cent.

There also were reported isolated cases of extreme hikes—of 300 per cent for a resident of a Denver tourist camp, and 200 per cent at a St. Louis hotel. New York City reported boosts of up to 50 per cent were fairly common and one hostelry raised rates 125 per cent.

**Some Stay Same**  
In contrast to increases by some hotels, there were others in some cities which announced there would be no boosts in rents for permanent residents. These included the Stevens in Chicago, the world's largest; the Somerset in Boston and the White Plaza in Dallas, Tex.

In some cities many hotels did not disclose their immediate plans under the new law. Some confusion was reported among tenants and landlords alike as they sought interpretation of the act. Federal rent offices were swamped by callers seeking explanation.

In Denver, Gov. Lee Knous of Colorado said he had received reports of several "sharp" rent jumps, including a hike of 300 per cent for a tourist camp resident whose rent was raised to \$240 a month. In Los Angeles, H. K. D. Peachy, acting area rent director, said there was

evidence of eviction notices in "wholesale quantities" over Los Angeles county. He advised tenants to await court action.

Lolicama, former owner, are indefinite. He has operated the store for three years.

## Receipts Hit \$2,764.17

Receipts of the county clerk's office for the month of June totaled \$2,764.17. This figure does not include \$2340.50 in support receipts taken in by the recorder's section. Of that amount, \$2237.50 was paid out this month in support payments. The remainder in the support fund is \$103. All but \$18 will probably be disbursed before the books are submitted to the auditor.

Of the \$2764.17 in receipts, \$1542.80 represents income from recording fees, marriage and dog licenses and adoption fees.

On July 5, three categories of recording fees will be increased, according to the county clerk's office. These include the fee for recording law and equity cases other than divorce tippd from \$11.20 to \$13.60, the charge for recording a divorce up from \$16.20 to \$18.60, and trial and appearance fee up from \$5.60 to \$6.80.
