

Wonderland Area Gets Publicity

REDDING, July 9—Recreational prospects in the nine counties of the Shasta-Cascade region are coming in for renewed attention throughout the West this month as a result of several new promotional campaigns.

Southwest Airways company has announced a new series of newspaper advertisements for release in publications outside the Wonderland area, calling attention to vacation prospects in Northern California and Southern Oregon.

Wonderland association officials revealed also that a new series of magazine articles is being prepared on three specific recreational areas: the Marble Mountain Primitive area in western Bliskiyou county; the Hart Mountain antelope refuge near Lakeview and the Modoc lava beds, near Alturas.

In addition, hunting and fishing prospects in the region east of Lassen Volcanic national park are to be publicized through radio releases late this month and early in August.

Resort operations in the Wonderland are regarded as "better than last year," operators say that they are receiving more reservations for late summer and early fall than last year, indicating a good season in the hunting and fishing areas.

Klamath Flying News

Search For Lost Aircraft
A group of six planes will start out Thursday from the Klamath airport on a search tour for two planes which were lost last winter. It was agreed at a meeting Tuesday night of the Klamath Air Search and Rescue unit.

Cliff Hogue, president of the KASRU will be in charge of the flight searching for an army surplus plane piloted by Robert R. Bottom which disappeared sometime in December, 1946, and a Navion flown by Locke which was reported missing February 16 this year.

The search flight will cover the area from Odell lake to the Three Sisters. Starting from Beaver marsh the planes will fly about a mile apart at a low altitude straight to the slopes of the Three Sisters and westerly from there to the Taylor burn; in a southerly line from here to Diamond lake which is parallel to Beaver marsh on an east-west line. From the start at the marsh,

the south-east boundary of the territory to be searched, the planes will spread out covering an area about 10 miles wide. The flight will commence at 10 a. m. and pilots will keep a sharp lookout for any evidence in the wooded area.

Special Meeting

Mosquito-Free Picnics
Groups planning picnics next week at Moore park will be pleasantly surprised at the lack of mosquitoes there. Some morning this week about 5 o'clock Cliff Hogue will fly Murel Long's Piper cub rigged with spray equipment and treat the park with DD-T solution

supplied by the city. Permission for this project and agreement to supply the material was granted by Mayor Ed Ostendorf.
Complaints against mosquitoes from numbers of people using the park resulted in the plan to treat it with this spray which has been found to be effective in numerous experiments made by Long and Hogue, for a period of about three weeks. The operation is made early in the morning as it has been found that the wind doesn't usually start up much before 7 a. m. and in a quiet atmosphere the spray can be directed to the spots harboring the insects with more accuracy than in turbulent air.

Expansion Of Hog Raising Seen
PORTLAND, July 10 (AP)—A prediction that grain surpluses in the Pacific Northwest the next few years would lead to expansion of hog raising was made here by Dr. Merwyn P. Chapman, Oregon State college veterinarian.

Dr. Chapman spoke at the closing session of the Northwest Veterinary Medical association.

Washington Has 18-Day Season
SEATTLE, July 9 (AP)—A general 18-day season for deer running from Oct. 12 through 29 was set by the Washington state game commission yesterday. The closing date was extended to Nov. 5 in Okanogan, Ferry, Douglas, Spokane, Pend Oreille and Stevens counties, and that part of Chelan north and west of the Blewett pass highway.

Other seasons designated:
Bear—open year around in Western Washington and during deer season on the east side.
Elk—Nov. 2-8 with Skagit and Whatcom counties excluded. A controlled hunt for 300 permit holders scheduled for Nov. 27-29 in Wenatchee area of Yakima and Kittitas counties.

The commission also tentatively withdrew its dates of Oct. 12-29 for the upland bird season.
