FORT KLAMATH—Lee Hague, employed near here in logging by May and Hayden, logging contractors, received painful injuries in a logging accident last Wednesday when he was struck on the back of the frame of a bulldozer under which he was working. The accident occurred just as work in the woods was done for the day, and the injured man was taken to the hospital immediately upon the arrival of an ambulance from Klamath Falls. In addition to minor injuries, Hague is suffering from a broken pelvis which will confine him to the hospital for some time. Hague and his wife live here, at the Margaret Watson apartment house.
