Most Stocks Slip Down

NEW YORK, July 17 (AP)—Late selling, while not particularly urgent, put most stock market leaders on the downside today despite quiet strength exhibited by a handful of special issues.

The packing group enjoyed an upward flurry around midday with Armco coming out in blocks running to 10,000 shares. There was little follow through, though, and trends began to wane in most departments at the approach of the final hour.

CHICAGO, July 17 (AP)—Grains suffered wide losses on the board today in fairly heavy trading. Uncertainty concerning the next move of the Commodity Credit Corporation, which yesterday withdrew from the cash wheat market, prompted selling of the bread cereal.

An expansion in offerings of cash wheat to this market was another depressing factor. Corn broke sharply as reports reached the trade from the major producing belt that a favorable weather lead spurred growth of the yellow grain.
