TSINGTAO, China, July 18 (AP)—Approximately 260 families totaling 470 Soviet citizens, roughly 67 per cent of the Russians here, have registered for repatriation.

However, the repatriation quota for Peiping, Tientsin and Tsingtao combined is but 1000 families and it was doubtful that all who registered would go to Russia.

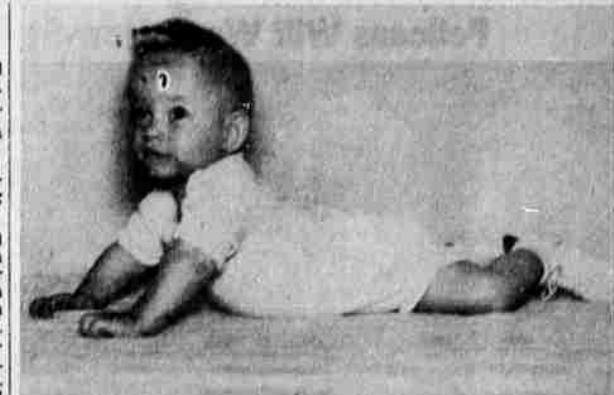
