Money Agreed For Interior

WASHINGTON, July 21 (AP)—House-Senate conferees Saturday agreed on compromise legislation providing \$194,800,000 for operation of the interior department during the fiscal year ending next June 30.

This compares with \$215,000,000 voted by the senate and \$161,000,000 approved by the house. Most of these funds are spent upon reclamation, irrigation and power projects in the Western states.

The conference report now goes to the house for ratification, then to the senate. Senator Wherry (R-Nebr.), head of the senate conferees, told reporters that for the Bonneville Power Administration at Portland, Ore., the conference agreed to set up \$8,506,400 cash and \$4,935,500 in contractual authority.

Police Arrest Two Men

Only two prisoners were brought to the county jail over the weekend, one on a drunk and disorderly charge and the other for shoplifting.

John Cooper, 49, pleaded guilty to a charge of petty larceny in justice court this morning and was sentenced to 10 days in jail. He admitted taking a pair of dress trousers from the J. C. Penney store Saturday afternoon.

Cooper was arrested by city police and held in the city jail until this morning. Alfred Austin Keaton, 4012 Austin, was lodged in the county lockup yesterday after being arrested at the fairgrounds by state police on charges of being drunk on a public highway and disorderly conduct.

Roy Cadden, 23, posted \$50 bail with city police early Sunday after he was arrested on a charge of reckless driving. The arresting officer reported that he chased Cadden's car 14 blocks out Shasta way before it was stopped.
