

Mountain Top Camera Shot Reveals Suburbs' Size



This picture taken from Hogback mountain lookout shows a section of the Klamath valley with Mt. Shasta in the background—but that sprawling settlement in the foreground is not Klamath

Falls. It is the Klamath Falls southeast suburbs, where some 10,000 people have their homes. None of the area within municipal limits is shown in the picture—it all lies off to the right. And those

streaks in the sky are clouds—not flying saucers. Ted Durment of Weyerhaeuser Timber company took this striking panoramic view.

Hogback Lookout Camera Vantage Point

Hogback mountain lookout offers some unusual opportunities for camera fans, both from the mountaintop and from the valley looking up at it.

Ted Durment of Weyerhaeuser Timber company, who edits the March of Pine, was on the lookout post the other day and got a number of interesting views. One of them, which appears on this page, showed a striking view of

the suburbs, the valley and Mt. Shasta in the background.

Hal Ogle, manager of Klamath Forest Protective association, and The Herald and News, are working on an idea for a picture-taking experiment in connection with Hogback. It is planned to provide some special lighting, with flares and lanterns, on the mountaintop at an appointed time. This will be announced in advance, so

that local camera enthusiasts who would like to try a night shot of the mountain and its lights can be at good vantage points, tripods set up, all ready for a time exposure.
