

# City Issues Studied For October Vote

Only one municipal item is scheduled for the October 7 state election ballot, but Mayor Ed Ostendorf said this morning that there may be other city issues to be voted on at that time.

The one definite issue will concern parking meters. When the meters were installed last January it was with the understanding that city voters would have a chance to pass on whether to keep them or throw them out after a six-month trial period.

The trial period is concluded this month, but the city council has decided to let the meters operate on until October 7, when the state holds an election, rather than to go to the expense of having a private city voting.

On the state level two important bills passed by the legislature last winter will come up for the voters' approval or veto. One is the 3 percent sales tax, which was referred to the people by the legislature directly, and the other is the 2-cent per cigarette tax which the legislature okayed but which is being placed on the ballot by referendum.

## Electronic School Calls McChesney

Paul R. McChesney, 19, F 2/c with the navy's Seabees, son of Mrs. Mary McChesney, 127 Mortimer, is going to electronics material school at Treasure Island, San Francisco, for 42 weeks of intensive training in the maintenance of radio and radar equipment, according to a letter recently received by Mrs. McChesney from Paul.

The school is to begin on the 4th of August and McChesney is at present waiting at Fort Huachuca, Calif. He recently returned from duty on Midway.

McChesney joined the navy in September, 1946, following a period spent in the navy's V-5 program at the University of California. He was sent to a naval telephone maintenance school after his boot training, graduating on March 7, 1947. Shortly after he was sent to Midway.

Having passed a test conducted by the navy to select men for electronics maintenance training, McChesney was relieved of duty on Midway and sent to the mainland. According to advice included in the letter to his mother, he has been informed the school offers one of the toughest courses of training conducted by the navy.

## Phillips Plan Special Topic

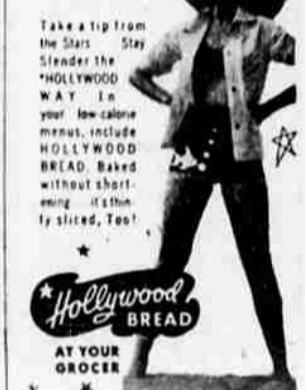
