

Ships Crew Quiet About Mutiny Tale

ESQUIMALT, B. C., July 30 (CP) —Crew members of the cable ship *Restorer* which docked here after seven months in the South Seas, amid coast-wide rumors of mutiny aboard, will meet with union leaders today to thrash out complaints of friction between United States and Canadian personnel, unsatisfactory food and unwarranted discrimination between officers and men.

The 3,180-ton Commercial Pacific company ship, of which all but five of the crew are Canadian, docked here yesterday after cable laying operations during which the vessel was laid up for three weeks at Manila when the men refused to continue working under prevailing living conditions.

Crew members, who declined to be named, said a trip to Singapore was called off due to "trouble" in Manila harbor when the United States coast guard was called in but took no action.

Captain J. H. Connelly, master of the ship registered in New York, declined to confirm or deny reports of serious unrest among the crew.

Crew members said they held a meeting in Manila and made complaints about poor food and lack of cold water. But after they "received a proposition" from the captain, they sailed the ship home.

Freight Rate Parity Seen Soon

OLYMPIA, July 30 (AP)—Atty. Gen. Smith Troy said today he is "confident" that western freight rates will be placed on a parity with the rest of the nation "in the not too distant future."

He declined to elaborate on his statement but characterized progress in the campaign as "wonderful."

At the same time, Troy disclosed that Governor Wallgren has offered to finance his campaign for lowered rates with funds from a \$1,000,000 emergency fund provided by the 1947 legislature.

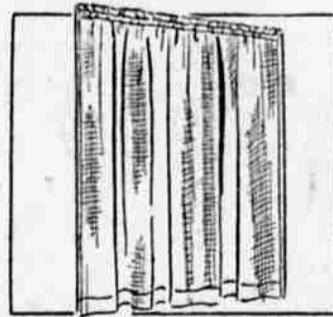

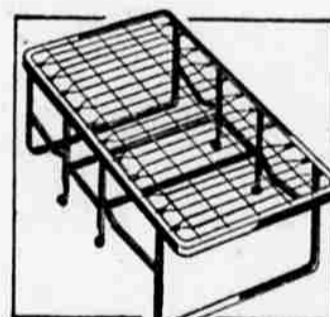
