AIR FORCE DAY
 Acting Governor Marshall E. Cornett, has designated Friday, August 1, as Air Force day in Oregon, commemorating the 40th anniversary of the United States air forces.

The Oregon air national guard will salute the state on Friday with three flights of P-51 fighters and one flight of A-26 attack bombers, from Portland, circling over Klamath Falls, Astoria, Seaside, Salem, Albany, Corvallis, Eugene and back over Bend, Pendleton, The Dalles, Hood River and return to the Portland base.

The Klamath Falls army recruiting station has prepared a seven-minute broadcast to be given by Sgt. Henry G. Morrison over radio station KPLW at 1 p. m. Friday, honoring the occasion.

Air Rescue
 Demonstrations at the Lakeview air show Sunday with the Lakeland Flying service's Seabee were cut short by an emergency call for the amphibious plane to pick up a patient at Four-Mile lake, 5680 feet high in the Cascades.

Penny Payne left immediately on the rescue mission, putting down on the water of Four-Mile just 40 minutes after the call was received. Bright clear weather at Lakeview was soon left behind and Payne flew the ambulance plane in under lowering skies and a drenching downpour.

The patient, George Hillis, Klamath Falls business man, injured while on the Sheriff's posse Skyline trail ride, was soon comfortably settled in the plane's bed and flown to Klamath Falls where an ambulance was waiting at the airport.

Tropic Current Heading In

ASTORIA, Ore., July 31 (AP)—Reports by tuna fishermen that temperature of Pacific waters 700 miles off shore is 70 degrees brought the explanation from meteorologists today that a tropical current had shifted inshore.

Unon Makey, captain of the trawler Starlite, said a reading showed 70 degrees—8 degrees higher than any previous report in that area.

Fishermen said the warm current also explained the large number of tropical species of tuna taken the past week, particularly

Clark Hits Rates Again

WASHINGTON, July 31 (AP)—Attorney General Clark in a new complaint today accused more than 900 railroads of collecting "unjust and unreasonable" rates on wartime shipments of steel airplane landing mats.

The action was filed with the interstate commerce commission. The government is asking reparations for alleged overcharges on the landing mats moved from eastern shipping points to Pacific coast ports between January 1, 1942 and June 30, 1946.

The justice department announcement said "thousands of carloads" of landing mats were involved. The petition to ICC states the exact amount of money sought to be recovered is "not presently ascertainable."

The complaint is another in a series which Clark has made before the ICC concerning wartime freight charges.
