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Nazi Blonde Waits Return

PHILADELPHIA, Aug. 4 (AP)—A 24-year-old blonde who served with the German army women's auxiliary corps, is awaiting deportation to Germany while a ship's cook who aided her in entering this country is being detained in Moyamensing prison charged with aiding the illegal entry of an alien into this country.

The ship's cook and baker, Walter Leroy Strang, 38, of Portland, Ore., testified before Magistrate E. David Keiser, sitting as a U. S. commissioner, that he loved Francesca Vandenberg, who succeeded in following him to Philadelphia.

Strang, who was held yesterday in default of \$500 bail, testified that he helped the girl, whom immigration officials said deserted her post with the German army in Paris, "because it was our only chance to get married."

The German girl, disguised in seaman's garb, was smuggled aboard the U. S. freighter Richard Moeckowski at LeHavre, France, and made the ocean crossing hidden in a cabin. Immigration officials arrested the couple early yesterday at a hotel here less than eight hours after they debarked.

Young Jews Rob Bank

JERUSALEM, Aug. 4 (AP)—Eight young Jews, including a girl, killed a Jewish official and wounded the Jewish manager of Barclay's bank in Haifa today and escaped with \$5200.

The fresh violence came after the Jewish underground issued a statement saying "we have not yet settled our hanging account with the British." They threatened new hangings.

Last week two young British sergeants, who had been kidnapped and held hostages for two weeks, were hanged in a forest preserve near Natanya, where they strangled and bled to death from wounds cut by the thin, knotted ropes.

The Barclay bank official who was shot to death had resisted the Jewish bandits. The bank manager was beaten until he opened the money box. Witnesses said the robbers escaped in a taxi.

Crowds outside the bank first tried to stop the escape, but dispersed when shots were fired into the air.

One of the prisoners, N. D. Collier, 417 Harrison Pl., San Antonio, allegedly was beaten unconscious. Other beaten included Robert L. Miller, 1704 Massachusetts St., Eugene, Ore.

Daughter To Identify Body

GRANTS PASS, Ore., Aug. 4 (AP)—The daughter of a missing Seattle man was expected here today in an attempt to establish identity of an elderly man found floating in the Rogue river here.

State Police Sgt. C. R. Borgman said Mrs. Philip Maynard (2312 N. 60th St.) Seattle, was en route here after the body of a man tentatively identified as Albert McClean, Seattle, was discovered floating, despite rock filled pockets, in the river.

Sgt. Borgman said Mrs. Maynard had notified Oregon police Saturday she had received her father's suitcase by mail from Grants Pass. The officer said an unsigned note on the body read "This is my own doing." There were no papers in a wallet containing \$20. The body had been in the river several days.

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Police Hold 12 Chinese Kidnapers
SHANGHAI, Aug. 4 (AP)—Chinese military police today announced the arrest of a dozen kidnapers of a wealthy Chinese couple, and said the gang had demanded as ransom 22 1/2 tons of rice "of the best quality" and 12 carbines. The couple still has not been found.

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
