Most Stocks Show Losses

NEW YORK, Aug. 11 (AP)—A fairly good rally in recently weak motion picture stocks, with firmness of assorted industrials, propped the market today, although the accent was on the decline for numerous leaders.

Slowdowns were frequent after a moderately active opening. Top gains of fractions to around 2 points were reduced in the majority of cases at the close and losses of as much as 10 points were in the vicinity of 750,000 shares.

Among featured winners, aided by word from London that there was some hope of a compromise of the heavy tax on American films, were Paramount, Loew's, Twentieth Century-Fox, Universal and Columbia Pictures.

American Telephone exhibited strength, buoyed by the thought that this stock had been oversold. Resistant were Southeastern Greyhound, Lima Locomotive, Western Union "A", Westinghouse, U. S. Gypsum, Republic Steel and Public Service of N. J.

Bonds were uneven, commodities reacted with corn down the day's limit of 8 cents a bushel at one time. This cereal ended off 4 1/2 to 7 1/2, wheat 2 1/2 to 4 and oats 1 1/2 to 2 1/2. Cotton, toward the finish, was \$1.75 to \$2.80 a bale lower.

Grain Market Jittery

CHICAGO, Aug. 11 (AP)—Wide price fluctuations, frequent reversals of trend and a highly nervous market featured trading in grains on the board of trade today.

At one time all corn contracts reached new seasonal highs and September corn spurted to \$2.42 1/2, a record for any corn contract here. At another time all yellow cereal contracts were down 8 cents, the limit permitted in a single session.

Between those extremes the market moved up and down readily, price changes of several cents being recorded within a few minutes. For the most part corn was under the final prices of last Saturday. Wheat and oats also hovered below the preceding close.

During the early trading No. 2 yellow corn sold in the spot market at \$2.51 a bushel, a new record high for yellow corn, while the very scarce No. 1 white corn brought \$2.86, a new record for any type of corn.

Wheat closed 2 1/2 to 4 cents lower, September \$2.35 1/2, corn was 4 1/2 to 7 1/2 lower, September \$2.33-\$2.33 1/2, and oats were 1 1/2 to 2 1/2 lower, September \$1.03 1/2-1 1/4.

Wheat Crop Record Seen

WASHINGTON, Aug. 11 (AP)—The agriculture department today forecast production of this year's weather-hampered corn crop at 2,650,940,000 bushels and a record wheat crop of 4,277,747,000 bushels. The corn estimate, based on conditions of August 1, compares with 2,770,830,000 forecast in a special report for July 15 and with a July 1 figure of 2,612,809,000.

It is considerably short of last year's record corn crop of 3,287,927,000 bushels, but compares favorably with the 10-year (1936-45) average of 2,639,102,000. The government's production goal was 3,000,000,000 bushels. A crop of at least 3,000,000,000 bushels of good quality corn will be needed to maintain livestock production at present high levels.

The estimate for wheat compares with last year's crop of 1,155,715,000, which was the largest to that time, and with the 10-year average of 890,306,000. This big crop will enable the United States to continue exporting large quantities of the grain to shortage areas abroad.

Fourth Quarter Taxes Due
