## Stocks Show Slow Recovery

NEW YORK, Aug. 12 (AP)—The stock market negotiated a creeping recovery today with steel, motors, rails and industrial specials adding fractions to 2 or more points at the best.

Slowness of the comeback—the ticker tape frequently dozed—was a bit discouraging to bullish contingents. Light offerings appeared here and there in the final hour and top marks were reduced in most cases at the close. Transfers remained in the vicinity of 700 shares for the full proceedings.

Better performers included U. S. Steel, Bethlehem, Youngstown Sheet, Chrysler, General Motors, Reo Motors, Montgomery Ward, Woolworth, Santa Fe, Southern Pacific, Southern Railway, Norfolk & Western, Western Union, A. T. & T., Standard Oil, Allied Chemical, American Smelting, International Harvester, Douglas Aircraft, Curtiss-Wright, "A" (on the first dividend this year), Boeing, Shell Union Oil, American Woolen, 20th Century Fox, Paramount Pictures, Texas Pacific Coal & Oil, International Paper and Southeastern Greyhound.

Bonds were uneven. Commodities stumbled after an early advance. Cotton, toward the finish, was off 15 to 75 cents a bale. At Chicago wheat ended unchanged to down 1 cent a bushel, corn off 1 1/2 to 3 1/2, and oats up 1/4 to down 1/4.

## Wheat Slow On Market

CHICAGO, Aug. 12 (AP)—Rapidly changing prices marked today's grain futures session at the board of trade. Up sharply at the opening in active trading, grains reversed the trend midway through the session on reports of rain in Iowa, Nebraska and Minnesota.

At one time corn lost as much as nine cents from the day's high mark before a mild rally lifted prices.

Toward the end of the session wheat and oats rallied.

At the end of the session wheat was unchanged to 1 cent lower than the previous close, September \$2.34. Corn was 1/4 to 3/4 lower, September \$2.31. Oats were 1/4 higher to 1/2 lower, September \$1.02 1/2.

Frank Monaghan, president of the CIO union's local 44, said the workers had rejected in a meeting early today the company's latest wage concessions but agreed to continue at work another week under terms of the contract which expired at midnight.

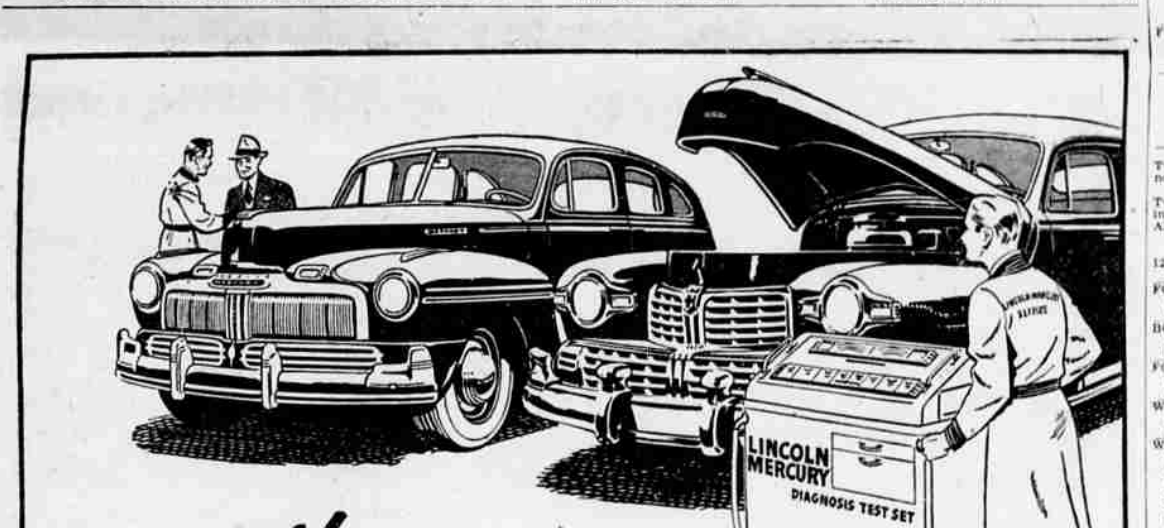
