

Meat Use Gains Over America

WASHINGTON, Dec. 3 (AP)—Americans are eating more meat now than they were two months ago when the government called upon them to eat less by observing meatless Tuesday.

This does not necessarily mean, however, that the meatless day campaign is failing to achieve its principal objective—a reduction in the feeding of grain to livestock so that more cereals might be made available for shipment abroad.

This is the season of the year when livestock marketing normally increases and when meat production goes up. It also is the season of the year when appetites for meat tend to grow sharper because of colder weather.

Meat production by federally-inspected slaughterers was running less than 300,000,000 pounds a week when the meatless Tuesday campaign was started. Now it is averaging more than 400,000,000 pounds and probably will go higher before the month is out.

The bulk of this increase is moving directly into consumption. As is the case normally, some of the seasonal increase is going into cold storage for sale later when supplies will be down.

Some of the current season's increase in meat production reflects earlier marketing of livestock, particularly hogs, that has been the case in the past few years. In other words, a lot of hogs which under conditions of the past few years would have been kept on farms for further fattening are coming to market now.

Evidence of this is contained in agriculture department reports that market supplies of hogs are running about eight pounds lighter than the 240 pounds average of a year ago.

King Denies Wedding Tale

LAUSANNE, Switzerland, Dec. 3 (AP)—King Mihai of Romania today denied Copenhagen reports of his imminent engagement to 24-year-old Princess Anne of Bourbon-Parma.

"There is absolutely nothing to it," the king told an interviewer. "I hear this story everywhere, and everybody knows more about it than I do."

Sources close to the Danish royal family said yesterday in Copenhagen betrothal of the 26-year-old king and the beautiful Danish princess, who once worked as a salesgirl in a Fifth avenue shop, would be announced within a month.

Employees at the exclusive hotel where the king is staying with his mother, Queen Helen, and his aunt, the Duchess of Aosta, said Princess Anne was constantly in the company of the royal party. An old porter said the king and princess "are quite friendly, even if they are not engaged."

32 Douks Get Prison Terms

NELSON, B. C., Dec. 3 (AP)—Amid screams of "It is not fair," and attempted disrupting by spectators, 31 Doukhobor men and 11 women were sentenced in police court yesterday to prison terms totaling 245 years on charges of riotous burning and arson.

After the sentencing, Doukhobor spectators assembled outside the courtroom crying:

"It is not fair. Some of us got seven years, some only 18 months. We are all the same."

The stiffest sentence was given Alex Panikoff—seven years for arson and 12 years for riotous burning to be served concurrently. His wife, Vera, received eight years for riotous burning and three for arson.

The sentences were the outgrowth of charges resulting from last summer's wave of fires which destroyed schools, community halls and churches in the West Kootenay valley.

Wife Slayer Held In Jail

BURNS, Dec. 3 (AP)—Claude Harry Melvin, 28, who disappeared after the gun death of his French war-bride Sunday, was held in jail here today after surrendering to police.

District Attorney Leland Duncan quoted the North African campaign veteran as saying he had wandered in a daze Sunday night and all day Monday, after helping police place his wife, Marie, in an ambulance.

The official said Melvin told of wrestling with his wife when she attempted to commit suicide with a .30 caliber rifle. She died in the Valley View hospital here late Sunday night and Sheriff Veldon Siza said she named her husband in the shooting in a death bed statement to a physician.

They were married in North Africa when he was with an army unit there. She came to this country more than a year ago. A nine-month-old baby survives.

A coroner's jury reported Monday she died of a bullet wound that was not self-inflicted.

Killjoy Asks Late Wedding Ban

PASADENA, Calif., Dec. 3 (AP)—Kenneth E. Ellerton wants a city law prohibiting wedding ceremonies after 10 p. m.

He appeared before the board of city directors yesterday and made his request. Ellerton's argument: Late weddings are noisy and seriously interfere with the sleeping of people who are not celebrating the event.

The city fathers apparently weren't impressed by the argument. They ordered the request filed and no action was taken.
