The Oregon State civil service commission has announced open competition examinations for the position of employment security deputy 1 with the state unemployment compensation commission and the state employment service. The salary range is \$199 to \$240 per month.

Applicants must have had one year of experience in business or governmental work and have completed at least two years of college, preferably with courses in public or business administration or appropriate social sciences, or have any equivalent combination of experience and training.

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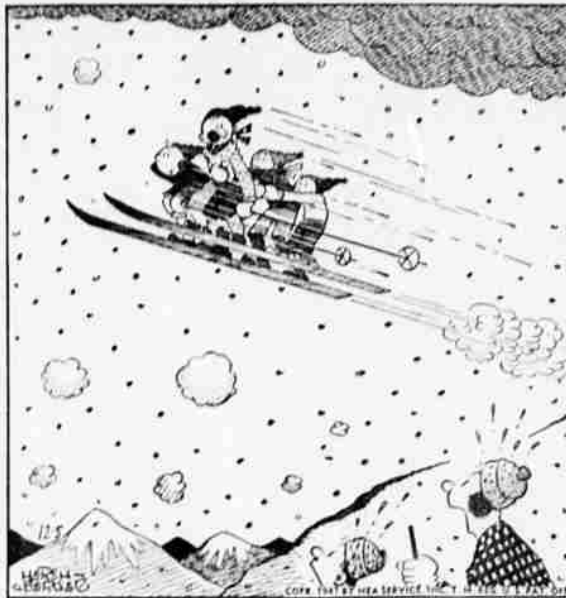
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Soule Is Chief Speaker

Prize exhibits will be decided today.

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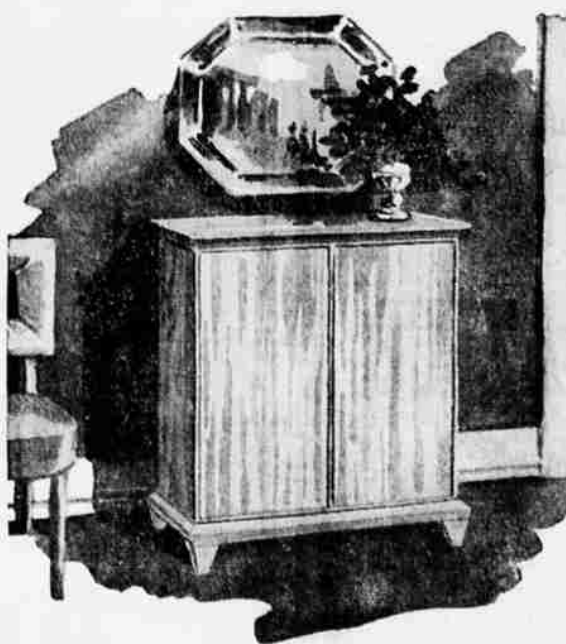
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meetings which would fall during the holiday season, December 24 and 31, to enable members to spend the evenings with their families.
