Demos Scorn Red Party

NEW YORK, Dec. 11 (AP)—The democratic party, its national chairman says, does not want the support of any communist-dominated organizations or those "so identified in the public mind."

Rhode Island Senator J. Howard McGrath, visiting New York for the first time since his appointment by President Truman to the democratic chairmanship, described his party's chances in the 1948 presidential election as "satisfactory," adding that major issues of the campaign would include high living costs, world reconstruction and the "inflationary trend."

He made his statements yesterday at a news conference preceding a private dinner attended by New

York democratic chieftains. McGrath responded with a quick "certainly" when newsmen asked whether the democrats would welcome the support of former Vice President Henry A. Wallace but declared he did not have the "slightest idea" whether it would be forthcoming.

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Ten Reindeer Flown To U. S.

NOME, Alaska, Dec. 11 (AP)—Ten of Santa's reindeer flew through northern skies yesterday en route south to the United States for a pre-Christmas visit.

The 10 animals flew to Anchorage in an Alaska Airlines plane, first stop on their trip to Detroit where

they will be displayed in a "Santa's workshop" at Dearborn, Mich. They will be flown to Seattle and then East.

Agents of Ed Butters, Cold Water, Mich., got the animals at Colovin, 75 miles east of Nome, and flew them here yesterday. It was believed the permit was the first granted in many years to take live reindeer out of Alaska.

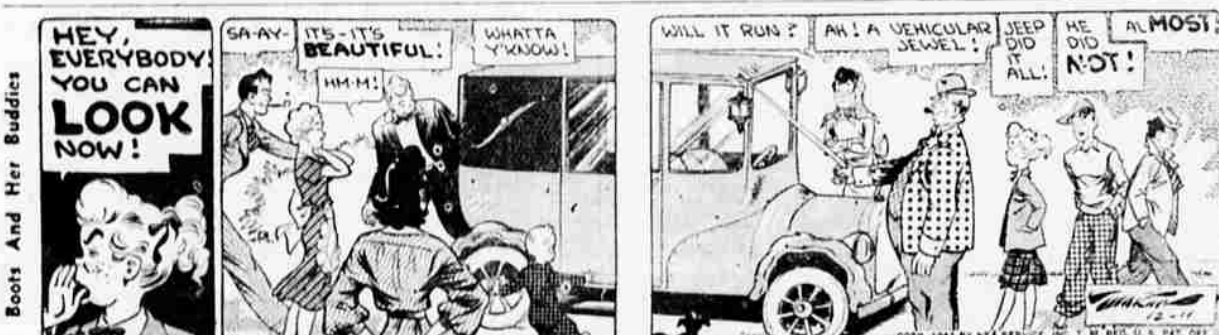
