## School Head Admits Theft

YAKIMA, Wash., Dec. 15 (AP)—W. B. Smith, 56-year-old superintendent of schools in Wenatchee and one of the organizers of Wenatchee junior college, was free today under \$100 bail after being arrested on a charge of petty larceny involving shoplifting at Yakima department stores.

The arrest was disclosed Saturday by Police Chief Harold Robinson, who said Smith had orally admitted theft of three shirts and other merchandise found in his car.

Two members of the Wenatchee school board came here and left with Smith after he was released on bail. Smith wrote out his resignation as superintendent of schools, Robinson said, when he was brought to police headquarters.

The police chief said he was told that Smith, a graduate of Washington State college, had suffered a nervous breakdown last spring.
