## Lake Rotary Club Gives 4-H Youngster Bay Trip

These eleven young farmers are the winners of a lamb feeding project sponsored by the Lakeview Rotary club. Here is why the youngsters are excited... and no wonder. The Lakeview Rotarians are giving them a trip to San Francisco.

This is the way the contest worked. The 185 lambs which the boys and girls have been fattening since the end of August are now ready for market. The lambs will be on their way to San Francisco markets by truck on Saturday, December 13. The young feeders are making their plans to arrive in the bay city in time to see their lambs at the stockyard after grading. Monday morning, the youngsters will see their stock sold. On Tuesday, the Lake county youth will visit the packing houses to see the lamb carcasses with the government grades stamped on the meat.

The San Francisco Rotary club is having the young Oregonians as guests at their Tuesday noon luncheon. And, the word is out that a sight-seeing tour of the city is also being planned.

The lamb feeding contest really won't be finished until the lambs have been slaughtered. The Lakeview Rotary club put this new twist into the contest. According to Elgin Cornett and Scott Cleveland, county agents in Lake county, the eleven winners are receiving round trip transportation to San Francisco from their homes. Here's the new angle: Four of the youngsters... two 4-H and two FFA... will receive all of their expenses for the trip. 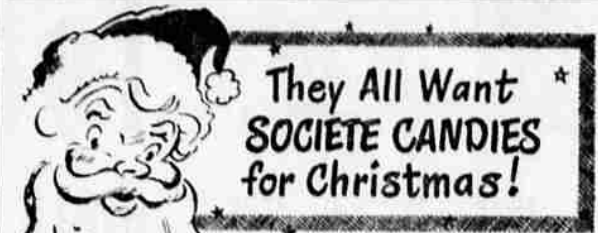
## Farm Prices To Stay Up

R. Brethaupt at OSU has just published a new Agricultural Situation and Outlook leaflet which is available through your local county agent's office.

total farm production in 1948 is less favorable than it was a year ago. Expected droughts in the winter wheat belt east of the Rockies are the reason. Pending rains are also more adverse for the production of meat, milk and poultry.

Despite this forecast, the country's agriculture in 1947 is expected to produce about 36 per cent more than the 1935-39 average.

The new outlook circular contains sections on farm income, land prices, rentals, and farm family living. Your county agent has a supply of the new Agricultural Situation and Outlook. Ask him for a copy.

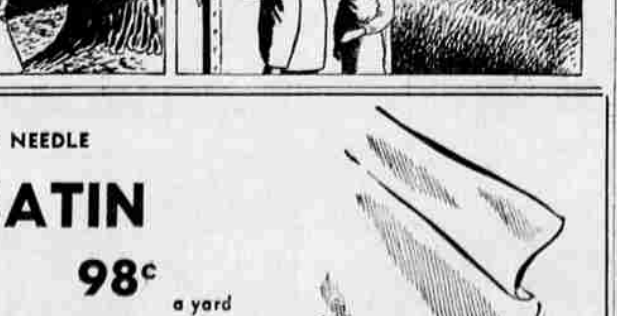
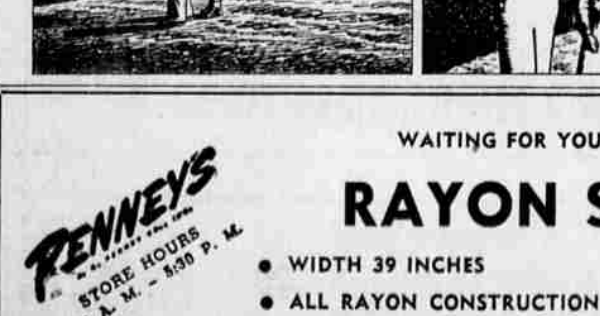
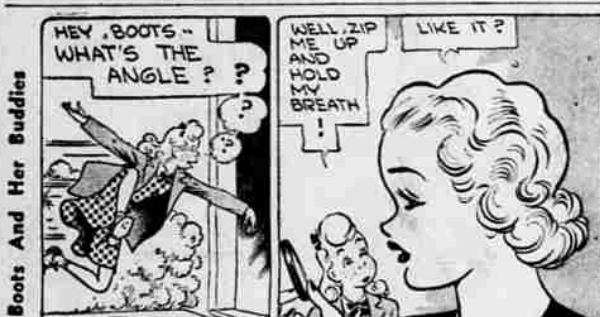
