

## Vet's Mail Bag

### TRAINING BENEFITS STILL AVAILABLE

Veterans who have discontinued school or on-the-job training under the GI bill or vocational rehabilitation act may, in nearly every case, resume training if they so desire, the VA stated this week.

A total of 166,483 veterans have started training in the Pacific Northwest, whose cases remain in the VA files. Of this number 91,575 have discontinued training.

The VA said that all but 706 of these veterans are still eligible for further training. Of the 706 ineligible, 506 are disabled veterans whose rehabilitation has been completed through training under public law 16. The remaining 200 are trainees who exhausted their eligibility while training under the GI bill.

The thousands of veterans who stopped their training are nearly all eligible for more training, the VA emphasized, in citing some of the fundamental eligibility regulations.

Under the GI bill, veterans who served 90 days between September 16, 1940, and July 25, 1947, and who were discharged under conditions other than dishonorable, are en-

titled to training benefits. The length of training depends upon the length of service, and the maximum benefit is for four years.

### LATEST FIGURES ON GI INSURANCE

Some 2450 Pacific Northwest veterans reinstated \$18,106,500 worth of national service life insurance during November, the VA disclosed this week. The VA said that insurance with a face value of \$330,604,500 has been put back in force by veterans since February.

Deadline for reinstating NSLI without a physical examination, except where the policy has lapsed for no longer than three months, is December 31, 1947. Realization of approach of the deadline has given impetus to the reinstatement campaign. Only two monthly premiums need be paid to reinstate term insurance, the VA emphasized.
