NEW YORK, Jan. 6 (AP)—Leading stocks resumed the downward drift in today's market with losses of fractions of 2 or more points widespread. There were a few wider drops by "thin" issues.

Light offerings prevailed from the start. Rails, oils, steels and amusements were in supply as nothing in the way of buying inspiration was discerned in the news. Aircrafts again attempted a forward push on talk of big military orders but eventually subsided. Few comebacks were in sight near the close. Transfers tapered to around 1,000,000 shares.

Mild resistance was displayed by Boeing Douglas Aircraft, Lockheed, Pan American Airways, Woolworth and Commonwealth Edison.

Loew's touched a low for the past several years. In the music ranks were Pennsylvania Railroad, Southern Railway, Great Northern Railroad, Union Pacific, Atlantic Coast Line, Western Corp., Gulf Oil, Pacific Western Oil, Shell Oil, Superior Oil, Phillips Petroleum, Paramount Pictures, Twentieth Century-Fox, Republic in Steel, Youngtown Sheet, Chrysler, U.
