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4-H Club Office Receives Rules For Safety Contest

Rules for the 1948 4-H farm safety contest have been received in the 4-H club office. Francis A. Skinner, county club agent, announced recently.

Any bonafide 4-H club member may participate in this activity. To be eligible for this contest, club members must complete work records and be between the ages of 14 and 21 years of age and must have completed at least three years of club work, including the current year.

The objectives of this contest are (1) to accept, practice and promote safety as a 4-H principle; (2) to contribute to the national welfare by preventing accidents and injuries to people or animals; (3) to practice and promote safety through proper maintenance and operation of automobiles, trucks, tractors and farm machinery; (4) to promote safe practices in the home, through the proper use and care of household equipment; (5) to check and remove from farm and house any conditions likely to cause fire, accidents or injuries; (6) to promote and aid safe methods and practices in farm life and work; (7) to help develop cooperation in fire-fighting; first aid and other safety work; and (8) to learn what are the more common accidents on farms and in homes.

The contest is sponsored by the General Motors company and the state winners will have an all-expense paid trip to the National 4-H club congress in Chicago next December. Entry blanks are available in the club agent's office and club members have until next fall to complete the contest.

To participate in this contest, club members must make an accident and fire prevention survey on the farm, make a list of 12 or more of these or other accident or fire hazards which were found, state definitely what was personally done to remove the hazards, and write a story of the activity.

Additional information and entry blanks are available in the club agent's office, Skinner added.
