

UO Chorus To Sing Here February 22

Arrangements have been completed by Andrew Loney, director of music education in the public schools, for the appearance in Klamath Falls of the University of Oregon mixed chorus of 40 voices under the direction of Prof. Don Allton.

This is the first annual tour of the mixer chorus which is composed of the finest voices from the university choral union. Assisting Andrew Loney and the music department will be John Houston and members of the University of Oregon alumni association. The concert will be presented in the high school auditorium on Sunday afternoon, February 22, at 3 p. m. and Loney assured that the program will be one of the "finest presentations of choral music ever to be offered in Klamath Falls."

The chorus will come here from Medford and arrangements for the housing of the chorus will be handled by the sponsors. A small admission charge will be made to cover the expense of bringing the chorus to this city.

Two-Story Houses Built

Under construction now and expected to be finished by March, are two two-story houses on Eldorado. These are large family homes, one having four bedrooms and nine rooms besides a basement, the other with three bedrooms and eight rooms in all.

Spacious living rooms with fireplaces of red scratch brick exposed are a part of each house, which is

finished outside with 10-inch pine siding painted white. Good-sized, but not immense windows are used, with 12 panes each.

Each house has a single garage finished outside to match, and plastered inside.

Stained shingle roofs are used on top with not too steep a pitch. Staid and conventional, these homes have an unusual dignity and long-lasting appearance.

E. P. Ivory and Joe A. Jones are building the houses for sale. Jones

drew up the designs, following a conventional pattern pretty closely. He is also the building contractor.

TRANSPORT REPAIRED

YOKOHAMA, Feb. 2 (AP)—Its storm-damaged hull repaired, the U. S. army transport General Omar Bundy will depart for San Francisco Wednesday. It will carry 1900 troops and first class passengers. The ship was damaged on a rough crossing from Seattle.

WAA Sales Cost Soars Upward

WASHINGTON, Feb. 2 (AP)—The cost of selling war surplus now amounts to about half the receipts, the war assets administration reported today.

Administrator Jess Larson told congress he still has to get rid of goods which cost the government about \$7,472,000,000 new. He expects the job to be pretty well finished about June 30.

Disposal costs, which amounted to 28.7 per cent of the money taken in during 1947, rose to 49 per cent in the final quarter.

The reason, Larson said, is that WAA's stocks are down to the not-so-choice and the "white elephant" items.

SHIPPING BILL

WASHINGTON, Feb. 2 (AP)—Canadian ships would be allowed to serve Alaska under a bill introduced by Sen. Capehart (R-Ind.) in explaining his effort to amend merchant marine laws, Capehart said present restrictions threaten development of the territory.

Canadian vessels now may carry passengers and supplies only between Canadian and Alaskan ports, but not between Alaskan ports.
