

Compromise May Come In Tule Ruckus

TULELAKE, Feb. 5 — Some compromise may be reached in the hot argument between the Tulelake-Butte Valley Sportsmen's association and the park service over extension of the Lava Beds Monument boundaries. This was indicated in a letter from Congressman Clair Engle to E. L. Booth, secretary of the association.

Engle advised that no definite action would be taken regarding inclusion of the peninsula area until the Tulelake-Butte Valley group had an opportunity to meet with federal representatives.

The park service has been considering absorbing a portion of the peninsula for the past 12 or 13 years, including it in the Lava Beds national monument, and has reached the point of asking the U. S. bureau of reclamation for a transfer of the property. The sportsmen association, interested in keeping this area for hunting and trap-shooting, has registered a protest against such transfer.

The city of Tulelake is also interested in this property. Booth said, desiring to put a cemetery in on the west side of the peninsula.

John Coulson, president of the association, is in Nevada at the present time and John Takacs Jr., vice president, is in Florida.

Punchboards Not For Mail

Punchboards sent through the mail will be considered a violation of the United States postal code. A bulletin received from the post office department advised Klamath Falls Postmaster Burt E. Hawkins to this effect today.

When evidence shows that a person or company is sending punchboards through the mail for the purpose of lotteries or as a "scheme for the distribution of money or of any real or personal property by lot, chance, or drawing of any kind," it shall be considered a violation, the bulletin explained, and shall be marked "fraudulent."

Federal regulations provide for a stiff penalty for sending lottery information of material through the mails.

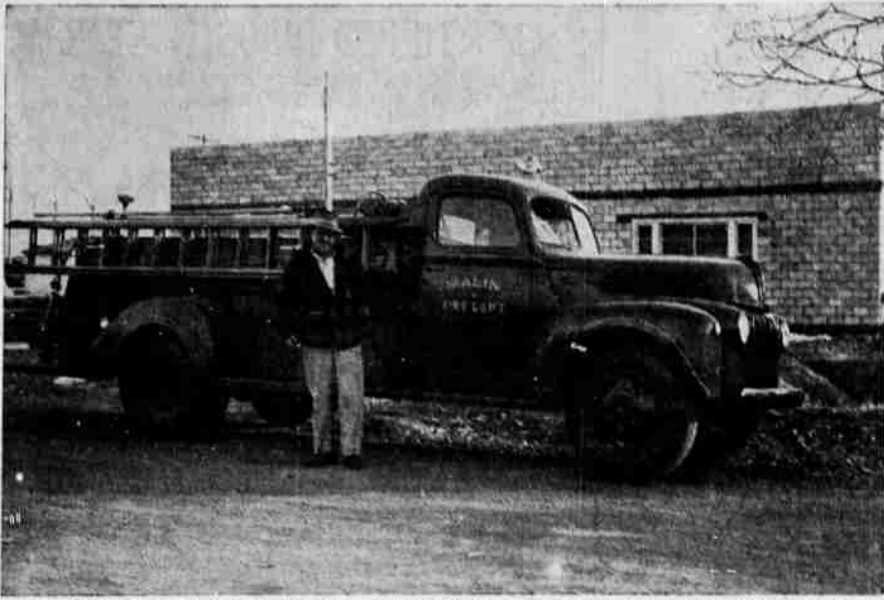

MUNICH, Germany, Feb. 5 (AP)—Investigations today failed to produce a trace of Fritz Kuhn, former German-American bund leader, or

to explain how he escaped Tuesday from a German internment camp in Dachau.

U. S. constabulary units moved into the widespread search. Camp inmates were questioned fruitlessly. German police were alerted to hunt

him throughout the American occupation zone.

So far authorities could not even establish the time when Kuhn appeared from the camp. He was awaiting trial by a German denazification court.

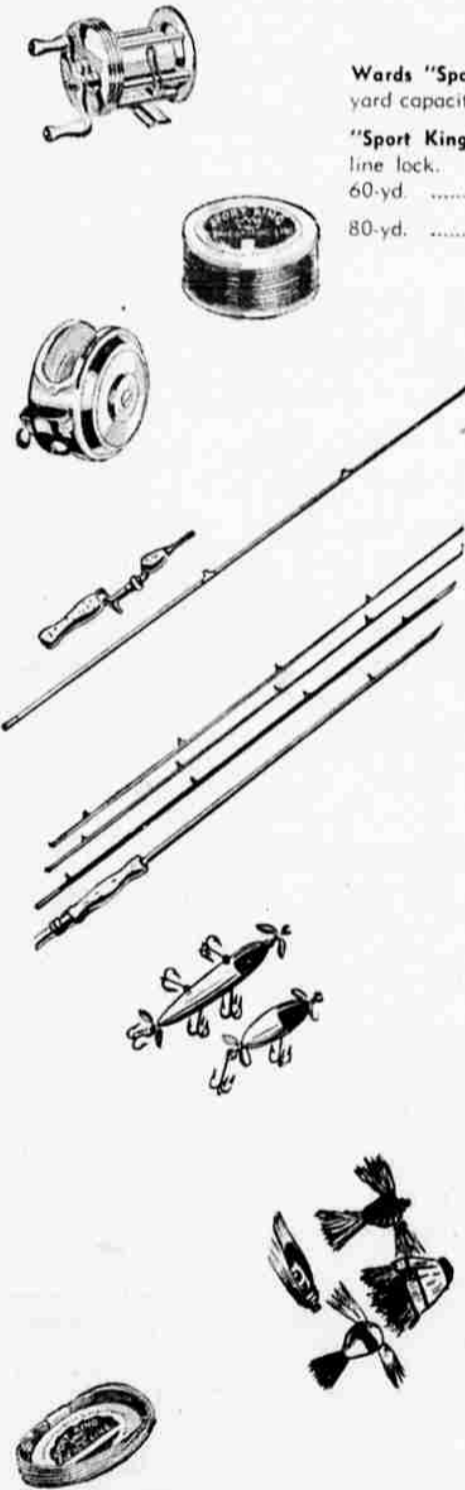
