

Red Bluff Bull Sale Is Success

"Most successful of all time," was the verdict on the seventh annual bull sale at Red Bluff, Calif., last week-end with the average per animal around \$765. Highest previous average was \$690.

A bull from the Crowe ranch in Shasta county caused considerable excitement bringing \$5600—the highest price paid during the seven years of Red Bluff sales. Top previous price was \$3500.

This year's champion brought \$3150, \$150 more than Don Liskey, Poe valley rancher and his him. A third place Curtis Martin bull brought \$3200.

Another Crowe ranch bull sold for \$3000 which was turned over to the March of Dimes fund. The bull was knocked off at \$1500 to the Moffat Meat company who put it up for re-sale. Liskey bid \$1500 the second time but lost to Charles Stover of Red Bluff for \$1500.

Liskey sold some bulls at the auction and purchased 13 head of heifers from the Curtis Martin ranch in Missouri, Mont., and the Peterson brothers ranch in Utah. He will breed the heifers to Publican Domino 36th, the bull purchased by Mabel Liskey at the Cow Palace in San Francisco last fall.

The champion pen of five was purchased by D. O. "Buck" Williams of the Yarnsey Land and Cattle company and the reserve champion pen of five went to Ed Keary of Geary brothers ranch Stanley Johnson also of Klamath basin purchased some bulls and Jim Stevenson of Macdoel bought some heifers. There were about 50 Klamath basin stockmen at the sale.

Oregon Teachers Said Undertrained

SALEM, Feb. 10 (AP)—One-fourth of Oregon's school teachers are undertrained, having little more than a high school education, Rex Putnam, state superintendent of public instruction, said today. The average teacher salary now is \$2909, compared with a national average of \$2000. Putnam said many Oregon teachers go to California and Washington because of higher salaries paid there.

Klan Refused Parade Permit

ANDERSON, S. C., Feb. 10 (AP)—The Ku Klux Klan asked the Anderson city council for a parade permit and received a prompt and uncompromising no. Mayor J. L. Sherard said that "no one wearing masks is going to parade in Anderson if I have anything to say about it."

Alderman James C. Catcher blamed everything on the "political big shots in Washington." They are trying to stir up trouble here in the south.

"If it ever comes to the point where the white people have to rise up," he added, "I'm ready to go just as I am dressed now. I am not in favor of any masked and hooded mob."

Reward Offered For Airpockets

NORFOLK, Neb., Feb. 10 (AP)—If you ever hit an "air pocket" and can prove it, you can collect \$1000 cash from the Nebraska Aviation Trades association.

Flying people "loathe the phrase... because there is no such thing," Association Secretary-Treasurer John Younglein said today in announcing the offer.

"Nature abhors a vacuum. There can no more be a hole in the air than there is in water," Younglein explained. However, air currents or winds that move up or down have been erroneously called "air pockets," said Younglein.
