

Politically Free Boss For European Post Held Certain Today

WASHINGTON, Feb. 11 (AP) — A European recovery boss who won't have to take orders from the state department appears a certainty today.

The senate foreign relations committee agreed unanimously last night to create a \$20,000-a-year independent Marshall plan administrator.

He would rank equally with the secretary of state and other cabinet members and any dispute would be settled by the president.

The administrator would be advised by a 12-member board of private citizens and would report to a

14-member congressional "watch-dog" committee.

A roving ambassador and special missions abroad would help keep tabs on how Europe uses the American help.

Chairman Vandenberg (R-Mich.) said the administrative plan was agreed to without dissent by the committee. He added that if the state department has any objections, he hadn't heard them.

The state department proposed originally that it be given full say over the recovery program. This encountered strong congressional opposition.

Senator Wherry (Neb.), acting senate republican leader, described the new plan as "very much improved." But he promised a fight over defining the exact powers of the administrator.

Wherry is chairman of a 20-member senate republican group which wants to make many changes in the multi-billion dollar Marshall plan. He said the present bill does not go far enough in saying what

the administrator can and cannot do.

There were hints from the house side of the capitol, too, that the senate plan won't satisfy all critics there.

Rep. Herter (R-Mass.), chairman of a special house committee on foreign aid, told a news conference that all assistance programs should be placed under a single administrator. The senate bill deals only with European aid which 16 Western European nations have asked for on a self-help basis.

Herter noted that the government has announced plans to help China and is considering additional military assistance for Greece and Turkey on top of the Marshall plan and its programs for occupied areas. He said "intelligent programming" requires that all phases of foreign relief be taken into consideration.

The administration has given congress an estimate of \$9,333,000,000 for all foreign aid for the 15-month period beginning April 1. Of this, \$6,800,000,000 is earmarked for the European recovery program.

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Two Perish In Blaze

ROSEBURG, Feb. 11 (AP) — A 21-year-old housewife and her small nephew perished late yesterday and two other members of the family were critically burned when fire destroyed two cottages south of here.

Mrs. Fay Aultman, 21, and three-year-old James Ogetree died in the Aultman home when kerosene exploded as Mrs. Aultman poured it into a wood range. The flames quickly engulfed the house.

Mrs. Aultman's husband, Paul, 26, ran from the house with his clothing afire. Mary Katherine Ogetree, age 5, also was burned seriously, but three other youngsters escaped unhurt. The injured are in Mercy hospital here.

State Police Sgt. Lyle Harrell said the adjoining home of Mr. and Mrs. J. Coltrin, stepfather and mother of the Ogetree children, was destroyed before firemen could control the blaze. The Coltrins were away from home at the time.

The fire started at about 4 p. m. and within a few minutes both cottages were in flames. The houses were part of the Kennedy mill community.

Saltonstall In Portland Today

PORTLAND, Feb. 11 (AP) — Senator Leverett Saltonstall (R-Mass.) arrived here last night to speak at the Lincoln Day banquet celebration sponsored by Oregon republicans.
