Gentle variable wind off coast backing to southerly and increasing to moderate to fresh at mouth of Columbia this afternoon.

Worker Held In Train Wreck Case

LILLE, France, Feb. 19 (AP)—Station Master Albert Dufour of Thumeries was jailed Wednesday on charges of involuntary manslaughter in connection with a train wreck last night which police said cost at least 24 lives.

The accident, caused when a passenger train collided with a freight train, occurred near Thumeries, 15 miles from here, just after the passenger train took aboard a number of factory workers here.

Police said Dufour told them he had had an argument with an employee and had become upset; that he prematurely gave a signal for the passenger train to leave Thumeries.

Sullivan's Gulch Vote Set May 21

PORTLAND, Feb. 19 (AP)—Portlanders will vote May 21 on a proposed two-mill tax to help finance the Sullivan's gulch highway.

The city council today referred the matter to the voters. The tax would raise \$1,750,000 in three years with which to pay 60 per cent of the right-of-way purchase price. The state would pay the other 40 per cent for the route proposed as a high-speed highway through East Portland.

Construction cost would be borne jointly by the state and the federal roads administration.
