

Wallace Lashes Out At Marshall Plan As Road To Third World Conflict

WASHINGTON, Feb. 24 (AP)—Henry A. Wallace told an attentive house foreign affairs committee today the Marshall plan for European recovery would "take the nation down the road to World War III."

The third party presidential candidate said that "Wall Street monopolists" have transformed it into an instrument for enslaving Europe.

It was the first time Wallace, who used to preside over the senate as vice president, has made a formal appearance at the capitol since 1946.

Louisiana Political Pot Boils

NEW ORLEANS, Feb. 24 (AP)—Both sides predicted victory today as one of Louisiana's bitterest political feuds reached a showdown at the polls.

Rival candidates for governor in a democratic runoff primary election are Sam H. Jones, leader of the state's reform forces, and Earl K. Long, who has the support of the followers of his late brother, Senator Huey P. Long.

About 600,000 party leaders are expected to vote. The winner is assured of victory in the routine general election next April.

Second Clash

It is the second head-on clash between the two former governors. Jones won out in 1940 when Long opposed him with the Louisiana scandals still fresh in the minds of the electorate. Long had succeeded to the governorship upon the resignation of Richard W. Leche. No charges were brought against Long personally but the old Huey Long organization was reeling from the impact of the prosecutions.

Today, Jones is fighting an uphill battle. Long led him by 120,000 votes in a preliminary election January 20 when he polled more than 41 per cent of the total vote. He missed a majority by 109,406 ballots and the second primary campaign has been directed largely at the 228,223 voters who supported the two eliminated officeholders—Judge Robert F. Kennon and U. S. Rep. Jimmy Morrison.

Long forecast a triumph by 200,000 votes. Jones said it would be close, but predicted he would win.

The campaign was enlivened by charges of income tax fraud. In Washington a rules committee recommended an investigation but action by the house in advance of today's election was blocked.

War Gases

Mice Immunized Against Cancer—But No Cure Yet

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 23 (AP)—Mice have been immunized against some forms of cancer, Lankenau hospital's institute for cancer research disclosed today. A human blood test to detect the disease has worked in at least one case.

These developments in fighting the nation's second most deadly disease were reported as the American Cancer society gave the institute \$100,000 for research directed toward a cure.

But Dr. Stanley P. Reimann, institute director who accepted the society's gift, warned no new cancer cures have been found.

"We must guard against raising false hopes," he said.

The immunization work has been done with bacterial polysaccharides—a group of starches—the institute said.

It also disclosed it has been experimenting with teroperin, a folic acid derivative, which has growth-control powers.

Both polysaccharides and teroperin have been used on human patients. The folic acid derivative relieves symptoms of cancer and is a pain killer, the institute reported.

Dr. Hugh J. Creech, head of the institute's department of chemotherapy and immunochemistry, told about experiments with the multiple

starches. With them, he said, "I have immunized mice. There is no question about that."

But the polysaccharides "still fall short of what is needed for effective clinical use," he said.

Detection of cancer through a blood test was accomplished for the first time only two weeks ago, another institute scientist, Dr. Gail Miller, reported.

Dr. Miller said the patient had

was examined by X-ray and cancer was not indicated.

Then a test was made by passing an electric current through blood samples.

Dr. Miller described the test as "electrophoresis," a process which causes proteins to migrate to the negative and positive electrodes under the influence of an electric current.

It was bone cancer that was detected in the patient, Dr. Miller said.

Dr. Miller said the blood test method will be about 80 per cent effective in detecting bone cancer since only that percentage of bone cancer victims show the abnormal patterns.
