Chaos Feared In Holy Land

LAKE SUCCESS, Feb. 26 (AP) — Tryve Lie, secretary-general of the United Nations, said today Palestine will be chaos when the British withdraw unless the UN acts quickly.

He told his weekly news conference the UN becomes fully responsible for Palestine the moment the British leave. The British have said they will give up their Palestine mandate May 15 and withdraw completely by August 1.

Lie refrained from commenting on the Palestine declaration of the United States before the security council Tuesday or its implications.

He also declined to say whether the UN has legal authority to enforce decisions of the general assembly such as partitioning of Palestine.

He said that failure of the UN to carry out partition would reduce the prestige of the UN and lead to a general loss of confidence in its ability to settle world problems.

Lie spoke as the security council delegates took a breathing spell on the Palestine problem.
