

Seepage In Main Canal Worked On

An effort to correct seepage conditions along the main government canal within the city of Klamath Falls has been started by the reclamation bureau.

A dragline operation is now under way along the canal adjoining the Klamath Union high school property, where a trench is to be excavated and then backfilled with compacted material.

The program includes several methods of treating canal banks to make them watertight. The method used in the KUIS section was also employed on a 400-foot section near the Mountain House housing project on Alameda drive.

Other sections of the canal will be treated by boring holes in the bank and filling with oil, which, by seeping into the bank will seal the porous portion and make the bank watertight.

A "buried asphalt membrane" was used on a short test section of a newly constructed lateral supplying water to the Coppock bay area on Tule lake last summer. This method consists of excavating a layer of dirt from the inside slope and a portion of the bottom of the canal, then spraying the trimmed section with asphalt and covering with compacted earth material. The membrane forms a watertight seal and is protected from physical damage by the earth cover. This and other methods of a more experimental nature may be tried in the future as it seems feasible, it was reported by R. R. Best, district manager of the bureau of reclamation.
