

George Sees Shakeup In Demo Party

WASHINGTON, Feb. 27 (AP)—A shakeup in the embattled democratic party after the presidential election was predicted today by Senator George (D-Ga.).

Without passing on President Truman's chances in November, George said he believes southern opponents of Mr. Truman's civil rights program are going to have a great deal to say about the future complexion of their party.

As he spoke Dixie democrats fought a delaying action in congress against enactment of the civil rights plan. But in the southern states themselves, the drive to bar Mr. Truman's name on the official ballot gained momentum.

Sound Principles
"I think that as a result of this 1948 campaign we will have a chance to reorganize the democratic party on a basis of sound economic and good government principles," the Georgia senator told a reporter.

"I myself would be quite content to become a member of a minority party, so long as that party is based on sound principles. If it is, it will not remain the minority party for long."

But he said he was "not interested" in any move to make him a "favorite son" candidate for the presidential nomination.

George's statement was taken as an indication of how a number of the southern lawmakers in congress look upon their fight with the present leadership of the democratic party.

Several of them said privately they don't care if Mr. Truman is beaten by a republican in November. Many are looking to 1952 for a division of political sentiment along what they describe as conservative and liberal lines.

Moon Makes Good Television Subject

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 27 (AP)—Now the moon is on television.

Dr. Roy Marshall, director of the Franklin Institute, reports a television camera was wheeled up to the eye of a telescope focused on the moon last night and that lunar body was "on the air for nearly a minute."

"This is the first time that astronomy has been put on television," Dr. Marshall said.

"It opens up many possibilities. An astronomer may soon be able to sit in his office or home and see the sky and planets through television through the telescope may be several thousand miles away."

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Koreans Die In Raids

SEOUL, Feb. 27 (AP)—The U. S. army reported today 19 Koreans were killed in raids on police boxes in South Korea—attacks which American authorities described as communist-inspired.

U. S. occupation headquarters for South Korea said it was not certain whether the figure included the policeman and five or six civilians reported slain yesterday.

The raids were a renewal of outbreaks which U. S. authorities said are aimed at forcing the United Nations commission for Korea to leave the country. Russia denied the commission entry to its occupation zone in North Korea.

The U. S. army said 31 raids were conducted on police boxes in Cholla Pukio province. Telephone wires were cut and ties thrown across railroad tracks. The raids were similar to others February 7-8, in and near Seoul, when 47 were killed.

Japs Get Prison For Atrocities

YOKOHAMA, Feb. 27 (AP)—Mis-treatment of Maj. George "Pappy" Boyington, marine flying ace, and other prisoners brought prison sentences totaling 12 years to three former Japanese navy guards today.

The trio were guards at the notorious Ofuna war prisoner camp where the Okonagan, Wash. flier was taken after being shot down over Rabaul.

An eighth army military commission sentenced Kichi Yamazaki to six years, Masajiro Hirabayashi to four years and Suichi Shinoda to two years.

Logger Quizzed In Cabin Blast

PORTLAND, Feb. 27 (AP)—A Springfield logger was being questioned in Eugene today in connection with an explosion that ripped open the cabin where his ex-wife lived.

Two dynamite blasts blew out the side of the cabin, located just north of Portland, early yesterday. Mrs. Mabel Lane Cavette, 36, her three children, her son-in-law, and a roomer, asleep at the time, escaped harm, though one child was blown from his bed.

Two Multnomah county deputy sheriffs went to Eugene to question Rufus Cromwell Cavette, 50, about the explosion.

A suitcase with two home-made bombs and a shirt which two of Mrs. Cavette's children said they recognized was found 150 yards from the cabin.

Detective Henry Moore said he removed dynamite from the cabin several months ago.

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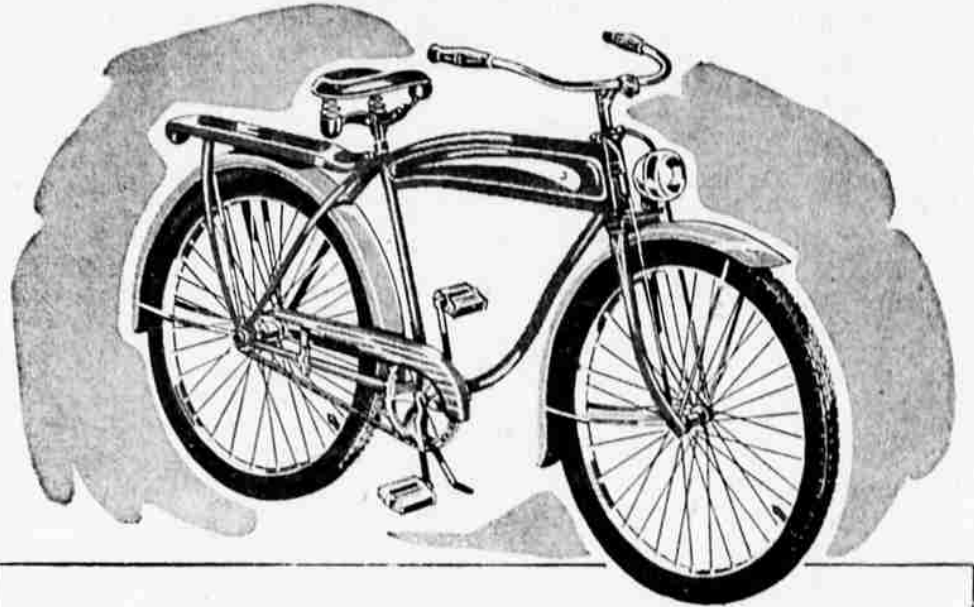


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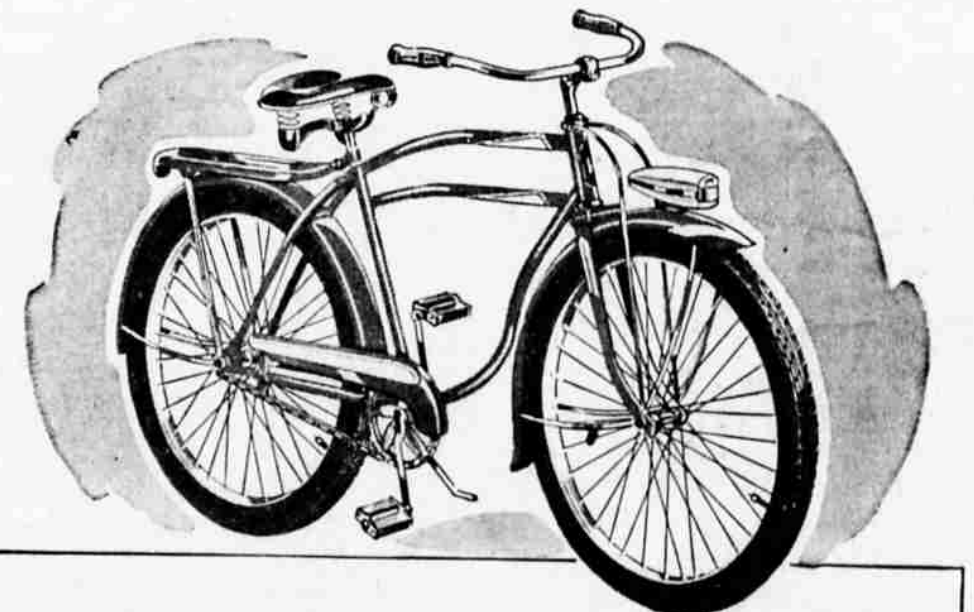


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
