## Grains Show Sharp Advance

CHICAGO, March 1 (AP)—Grains made sharp advances on the board of trade today in active dealings.

Small marketings of feed grains by country interests, a surprisingly pessimistic winter wheat crop report by the Santa Fe railway and unconfirmed trader rumors that the production and marketing administration had re-entered the flour market spurred aggressive buying.

At one time May corn was up 8 cents, the daily limit. Gains in wheat ranged to more than 9 cents at times. Soybeans were ahead their 8-cent daily limit.

Wheat closed 5 1/2-9 1/2 higher, May \$2.45 1/4, corn was 3 1/2 to 7 cents higher, May \$2.27, oats were 5-4 1/4 higher, May \$1.14 1/4, and soybeans were 8 cents higher, March \$3.62.

The Santa Fe railway said that in the southwest, "generally speaking, (wheat) conditions remain critical—it seems fair to give the crop an advance rating of 10 to 60 per cent of last year."

## Stocks Show Bulge Today

NEW YORK, March 1 (AP)—The stock market had some aspects of a March lion today although lamb-like tendencies still were in evidence.

Selected rails and aircraft led a forenoon bulge but dealings slowed after a fairly active opening. Extreme gains running to a point or more were reduced in most cases near the close. Transfers for the full proceedings held to about 800,000 shares.

Ahead the greater part of the session were Gaf Mobile and Ohio (a 1947-48 peak), Union Pacific, Illinois Central, Southern Pacific, Boeing, American Can, Eastman Kodak and Standard Oil (N. J.).

Accounts were reinstated in many instances on the idea the sharp relapse of February might indicate a substantial technical revival in the new month.

Bonds were steady with carrying in demand. Cotton, approaching the finish, was up 70 cents to \$22.20 a bale. At Chicago, wheat ended up 5 1/2 to 9 1/2 cents a bushel, corn 3 1/2 to 7 cents and oats 3 1/2 to 4 1/2 cents.
