Reds Beware—The Czechs Have Way Of Coming Back

NEW YORK, March 1 (AP)—American only fights one war at a time—European powers tend to have the next one always in mind.
That is why Soviet leaders asked that United States forces halt in 1945, so that Russian troops alone might have the glory of capturing Berlin and Prague, the capital of Czechoslovakia.



Soviet troops to link up with them. An order came down from higher headquarters bracing the American columns.
No Explanation
It was useless to try to explain to the pleading Czechs. They knew only that the Americans could have come to the defense of Prague and Berlin—and that the Russians did.
