

### Students From Algoma To Be In KF Schools

Elementary school students living in the vicinity of Algoma will next September start at Klamath Falls schools in accordance with the change of the northern boundary of elementary school district number one from the foot of Algoma hill on the south side to a point approximately five miles to the north, at Barclay springs.

The Klamath county court, acting as the school district boundary board, in making the change has settled a school placement problem of long standing. Grade-school students in the Algoma area have been shuttled from one school to another since 1942, when the school at Algoma was discontinued because of the decrease in enrollment.

At that time, the few children remaining were transported to Klamath Falls on the high school bus. Later, when the pupil population became greater, the children were transported to Altamont schools and then were moved to Chilcoquin this year, when the Chilcoquin bus extended its run from Modoc Point to Algoma.

Students will complete the present year at Chilcoquin elementary school and are to enroll in city schools in the fall.

### Driver Burns In Car Wreck

TACOMA, March 5 (AP)—Henry E. Powers, a Fort Lewis soldier, was burned to death today, a friend was painfully injured and two buildings set afire in a spectacular Pacific avenue accident.

Powers was driving an automobile which went out of control on a slight curve and skidded into gas pumps at a corner service station. Gas from the pumps caught fire, igniting the automobile, which rolled another 100 feet into the side of a business building.

Powers was trapped between the car and building and fatally burned before aid could reach him. His friend, James P. Schildt, 25, of Madigan General hospital, was cut and bruised but escaped being burned.

### Czech Switch Rumor Denied

PRAGUE, March 5 (AP)—Communist Premier Klement Gottwald's office denied today that President Eduard Benes is being replaced because of illness.

"The president is very tired and it is not known when he can come back to Prague," said Prantisek Necasek, chief of the premier's press section. "We do not know how long he may be ill. There has been no consideration given to any replacement or successor for him and, if any such step is taken, it will be according to the constitution."

Benes, a founder of the country, was elected to a seven-year term in 1946. The constitution provides that the president is unable to do his work for six months, three-fourths of the cabinet may decide to name a deputy vice president.

Necasek said Benes would be unable to speak in Prague Monday at the celebration of the battle of Sokolov, in which Czech soldiers fought alongside the red army.

"The premier asked permission to represent him at the celebration," the press officer said. "That is all."

### Study Of Drowning Made

CHICAGO, March 5.—The person who nearly drowns in sea water appears to have a better chance of being revived than a fresh water victim.

An article in the Journal of the American Medical association stated this conclusion today after comparing the effects of the two kinds of water in the lungs.

Experiments at the University of Texas, medical branch indicate, the Journal said, that in fresh water drowning the blood of a victim may dilute as much as twice its volume. In sea water drowning, however, nearly a third of the water of the blood leaves rapidly and the other constituents of blood tend to concentrate.

"The studies also showed that the heart continues to function nearly twice as long in sea water drowning as in fresh water drowning."

### Pope Denies Marriage Plea

WASHINGTON, March 5 (AP)—The National Catholic Welfare conference news service says Pope Pius has refused a dispensation for Danish Princess Anne, a Roman Catholic, to marry former King Mihai of Romania. Mihai is a member of the Greek Orthodox church.

(Mihai sailed from Southampton, England, aboard the Queen Elizabeth today for the United States. He told reporters he would return to Europe soon to marry Princess Anne, who is in Paris.)

The NCWC news service, which goes to many Catholic publications, says in a dispatch from Rome its information on Pope Pius' refusal of a dispensation came from "very reliable sources here which are entirely unconnected with the Vatican."

The story continues:

"It is stated that former Queen Helen of Romania and Princess Renee of Bourbon-Parma, mothers of the young couple, went personally to the Pope to request the necessary dispensation. After the audience, they were heard to express disappointment over the holy father's refusal several times in the social circles during their short visit here."

### Old Age Pension Petition Accepted

SALEM, March 5 (AP)—The state elections division today accepted the preliminary petition for an initiative to provide minimum \$50 monthly old age pensions.

The measure, sponsored by a group of Portland pension leaders headed by Joe E. Dunne, was submitted several days ago, but was rejected because it was not in proper form.

The measure would appear on the ballot next November if the campaign to get signatures is successful.

The bill also would have the pension system administered by a single commissioner, instead of by the present state welfare commission.
