

Soviets Continue Attack On US With Charge Of Plan To Split Europe--Fight Reds

MOSCOW, March 9 (AP)—Russia maintained today that the United States is engineering a western power scheme to divide Europe and increase military strength in Germany for aggression against the Soviet Union.

In a note to the United States, Britain and France, Russia declared the western powers are trying to build up military potential in the Ruhr so as to "turn Western Europe into a strategic base for American imperialism in Europe with the purpose of aggression against the USSR."

Two Dam Plan Gets Favor

ARLINGTON, March 9 (AP)—Communities of this area advocate construction of two dams in place of the single project planned for the Columbia river near the mouth of the John Day river.

Mayor E. M. Hilden reports the proposed John Day dam would inundate all or portions of eight communities in the area.

He said sentiment was strong for the original two-dam project involving the John Day and Columbia rivers. This called for a dam at Arlington on the John Day river and another on the Columbia near the mouth of the John Day, he explained. None of the communities would suffer.

Hilden said the two-dam proposition would ask the army engineers to revise the proposed single dam program for river development at an April 6 hearing here.

Bid Dates Set For University Work

EUGENE, March 9 (AP)—Dates for opening bids on Oregon State's athletic pavilion and a women's dormitory at the University of Oregon have been set by the state board of higher education.

Bids for the \$1,825,000 dormitory will be opened March 16 and the \$1,500,000 pavilion on OSC on April 23.

Dr. R. E. Kleinmorge, chairman of the building committee, said income from the facilities would pay off the financing bonds.

Other projects set for bids are a classroom project at Oregon College of Education, Monmouth, and a heating plant addition at Oregon State. Bids for both will be opened April 6.

Beauty Rule Change Asked

EPHRATA, March 9 (AP)—The Ephrata chamber of commerce has asked sponsors of the Atlantic City "Miss America" contest to open the contest to all races.

Gray Graman, chamber manager, said the request was made because of refusal by the Omak chamber of commerce to enter the state contest because of "racial discrimination."

An Omak girl, Jesse Jim, won a nation-wide Indian beauty contest in 1927.

The "Miss America" contest is limited to members of the white race. Graham said 15 cities and counties already have entered the state beauty contest to be held during the Columbia basin jubilee in Ephrata next June. The winner will enter the Atlantic City pageant.



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Arms Dump Blast Kills 100 Chinese

SHANGHAI, March 9 (AP)—A Chinese ammunition dump exploded at Tsingtao today, leveling a city block and causing 250 casualties. An estimated 100 were killed.

U. S. navy sources here said the explosion occurred just before noon, within half a mile of docks where the USS Estes, flagship of the American Western Pacific fleet, and the navy hospital ship, Repose, are tied up.

Tsingtao is the Chinese base of the U. S. navy's Far Western fleet.

There were no immediate reports of casualties among American personnel at Tsingtao.

Cause Unknown

The explosion, set off by an undetermined cause, swept an area east of the docks.

Resulting fires left a mass of blackened ruins in a wide sector.

The Repose and all available U. S. navy medical facilities afloat and ashore immediately gave assistance. The fires raged for two hours.

The Repose staff is especially trained for disaster work. It swiftly went about the job of rescuing Chinese from fallen buildings and giving first aid.

No United States buildings were damaged.

Dewey-Stassen Clash In Primary

CONCORD, N. H., March 9 (AP)—Gov. Thomas E. Dewey of New York and Harold E. Stassen, former governor of Minnesota, matched strength today in New Hampshire's first-in-the-nation republican presidential primary.

Prospective delegates of both indicated they would throw their support to Sen. Arthur H. Vandenberg (R-Mich.) if a second choice became necessary later.

Clear, crisp weather assumes a

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heavy vote in the nation's first test at the ballot box in the 1948 campaign. It was estimated up to 55,000 voters would turn out.

It's a republican show as President Truman is opposed in the democratic primary for his party's endorsement.
