Corn Leads Grain Downturn

CHICAGO, March 18 (AP)—Corn led a downturn in grains on the board of trade today, the May yellow cereal dropping rather sharply at times and falling toward the close. Wheat and oats were off with corn early but rallied toward the close.

Active wheat futures closed 2 cents lower to 1/4 cent higher, May \$2.36-2.37. The infrequently traded March contract was off 1/4 cent. Corn ended 1/4-3/8 lower, May \$2.14-2.15, oats were 1/4 to 1/2 cent higher, May \$1.12-1.13, and soybeans were 1/2 to 1/4 cent lower, May \$3.44.

Stocks Still On Upgrade

NEW YORK, March 18 (AP)—Stocks generally resumed the recovery move in today's market with assorted war-classified issues in front.

Dealings, lively in the forenoon, tapered later. Aircrafts reverted to a narrow range but air transportation improved. Coppers exhibited strength, along with assorted steels and rails. Top gains running to 2 points or so were reduced in most cases near the close.

Although slowdowns eventuated after midday, transfers for the full proceedings held to around 900,000 shares.

Exceptions to the comeback included Pepsi-Cola which touched bottom for the year.

Among better performers were Curtiss-Wright common, Anaconda, Kennecott, Great Northern Railway, General Motors, American Woolen and International Paper.

Bonds steadied Cotton, toward the finish, was up 40 cents to \$11.5 a bale. At Chicago wheat ended off 1/4 cent a bushel to 1/4 cent, corn down 1/4 cent and oats off 1/4 cent to 1/4 cent.

Dance Hall Crash Kills 1

CHICAGO, March 18 (AP)—One woman was killed and more than 110 persons were injured last night when a large section of a third-floor dance hall collapsed under the weight of about 500 persons attending a St. Patrick's Day celebration.

Twelve of the 92 persons treated at six hospitals were reported in from serious to critical condition. Several other persons were given first aid treatment at the scene.

The dance and party, attended by men, women and children, was in the top floor of a three-story brick building.

The dead woman, who was removed from under the wreckage three hours after the floor caved in, was identified as Mrs. Ann Hunt, 35, mother of four children. Two of her children who were with her at the party and dance were not injured.

Form Marketing Figure Gains

PORTLAND, March 18 (AP)—Oregon's farm marketing in January brought \$2,728,000, the department of agriculture reported today. The amount was 12 per cent over January a year ago.

Drops in commodity prices in February expected to wipe out the January gain, the department noted.
