The entire Tulelake group of Future Farmers of America will attend the Junior Livestock International exposition at the Cow Palace in San Francisco, Vern Hemstreet, FFA supervisor, said today.

The boys will leave March 19, and remain at the Cow Palace the entire show. On Wednesday at 2 p. m. the Tulelake FFA steer will be sold at auction. This steer was a present from the Bank of America, is 16 months old and weighs 850 pounds. It will be shown by Frank Jones and Bob Laird.

Hemstreet and Ward Devlin, a member of the Tulelake high school faculty, will accompany the boys and the bull. This is the FFA chapter's first entry at the exposition. FFA chapters from Cedarville, Alturas, Etna and McArthur, Calif., will also be represented at the Cow Palace.

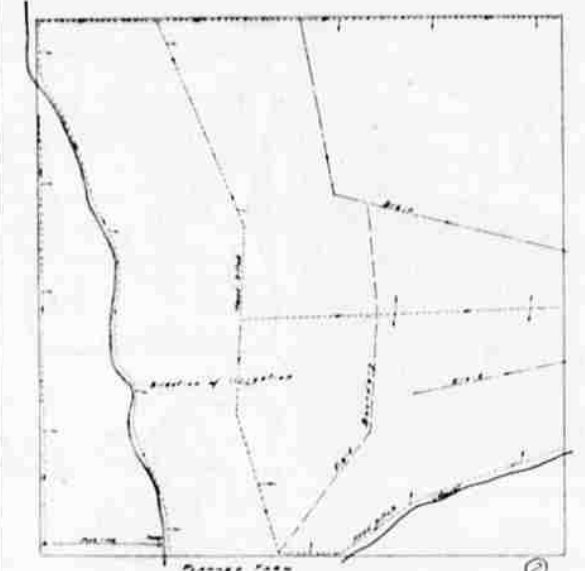

Proposed Conservation Plans



Map 2 shows the first step toward planned conservation farming and the irrigation system layout as proposed by SCS planning technicians.

Soil Saving Plan Mapped

Two maps of a farm in Langell valley, shown here, illustrate one of the jobs of the soil conservation service is doing in this region.

This farm, belonging to J. W. Dye, is in need of conservation work because long-term primitive irrigation practices have been used. Too much water was used to irrigate the high spots with the runoff or waste allowed to find its own way out.

The result was too much water and labor necessary to irrigate the upper part and causing an accumulation of alkali on the low areas.

Dye has requested advice from the Langell valley SCS district in working out a farm plan to get the best use of his land, water and time.

Different soils require different treatment, and Dye is being advised to first regulate water application and then reclaim the alkali areas, worst in the northwest corner of the farm, by cropping programs to suit the soil after irrigation and drainage systems recommended by SCS have been carried out.

Considerable leveling will be required to attain the desired result and will be possible to plan when the blue-print of the future farm has been made.

PORTLAND, March 18 (AP)—Oregon cattle ranches were increased slightly today when the corps of engineers said some Camp White and Camp Adair areas would be leased for grazing.

Bids on 360 acres at Camp Adair will be opened April 6 and on 421 acres at Camp White April 7.

Both areas are adjacent to national guard rifle ranges and must be fenced by the lessees.

Butterfat Label Ruling Made

PORTLAND, March 18 (AP)—The state director of agriculture ordered Portland area milk distributors Wednesday to begin labeling the butterfat content of all milk and cream by May 1.

The labeling order, issued last November, was postponed to enable distributors to use up their stock of bottle caps.
