

'Kidnaped, Victim Back In Custody

CONCORD, Vt., March 19 (AP)—The alleged kidnaper of a 16-year-old farmer's daughter was captured with her three miles from her village home today. Police said notes demanding food led them to the pair.

The girl was reported "OK" by State Police Commissioner Merritt Edson. Sheriff John H. Willson said Kenneth A. Ingalls, 34, and pretty Charlotte O'Brien told him:

"We didn't eat in four days and we had only melted snow for drinking."

"Infatuated"

Police charge Ingalls, an ex-convict and lumberjack, was "infatuated" with the high school girl and seized her at gunpoint from her parents Sunday night. He fired two blasts from a shotgun after threatening her parents, police said. He had worked on the O'Brien farm last summer.

Ingalls was taken to county jail at Guildhall and faced charges of kidnapping, and assault with a dangerous weapon.

The girl's father, Charles O'Brien, found the notes in a fuse box in his barn last night, a state trooper reported.

The trooper said O'Brien checked the fuse box when the lights went out in their home and found two notes demanding food and giving directions where to leave it.

One note was signed by Ingalls and the other by the girl, the trooper said.

Blast Death Toll Mounts

CENTRALIA, Ill., March 19 (AP)—The known death toll mounted to five today in an explosion which destroyed a two-story brick building in downtown Centralia last night.

Two bodies were found beneath the pile of rubble by firemen early today after an all-night search. Near midnight, about three hours after the blast, two bodies had been found in the wreckage. One woman died of injuries as she was being carried into a hospital.

Firemen continued to search through the ruins for other bodies after reports by eye-witnesses that some persons had been trapped when the structure collapsed.

Thirty persons were injured. Ten were reported in from serious to critical condition.

The building housed a tavern and a small pool hall-tavern on the first floor and small apartments and sleeping quarters in the nine rooms on the second floor.

The cause of the explosion had not been determined. Chief of Police O. T. Bounds estimated damage at \$40,000.

Clementis In Masaryk Job

PRAGUE, Czechoslovakia, March 19 (AP)—The Prague radio announced today that Vlado Clementis, a communist, has been appointed foreign minister of Czechoslovakia.

Clementis, who had been the No. 2 man in the foreign ministry, succeeds Jan Masaryk, who died in a plunge from his apartment in the foreign office building March 10.

The new foreign minister, a Slovak, had been secretary of state for foreign affairs and had been Masaryk's chief assistant for several years. He is a lawyer, 46 years old.

The Prague radio broadcast said the offices of foreign minister and secretary of state are being combined and that Clementis will fill both posts.

92 Escape Injury In Roaring Fires

VANCOUVER, B. C., March 19 (CP)—Ninety-two persons miraculously escaped two spectacular overnight fires here Thursday, which demolished the joint services' officers' mess at Jericho Beach and swept through an elevator shaft at Washington hotel in the East Hastings district.

The officers' mess was completely gutted and damage has been unofficially estimated at \$250,000. The hotel blaze caused only slight damage but forced the 80 guests to flee in night clothes.

Twelve Canadian army officers fled the inferno at the mess, the former Jericho Golf and Country club. Cause of the fire is still unknown but it is believed to have started in the lounge.
