

FFA Youths To Visit OVS For Confab

More than 800 Oregon Future Farmers will travel to the Oregon Vocational school April 8, 9 and 10 for the celebration of the 20th annual convention of the Oregon FFA association. This will be an all-time high attendance record according to Ralph L. Morgan, state supervisor of vocational agricultural education, Salem, who is state adviser for the FFA.

The reason for the large number of boys attending is that ample facilities are available at the school for housing and feeding the boys, their instructors and guests. The school theatre, with a capacity of 1200 persons, will serve as the convention hall.

Guest speakers at the convention will include Eugene Hansen, national FFA student secretary from East Garfield, Utah; and Bob Taylor, former national first vice president, from Grants Pass. Many other special guests have been invited. DeLaine Fry, Molalla, Oregon's state FFA president, will be in charge of the business sessions. Delegates from the 54 Oregon FFA chapters will be seated at the opening business session at 8:30 Thursday morning, April 8. Various judging contests will be held that afternoon with the state parliamentary contest finals Thursday evening. The new color motion picture "That Inspiring Task," filmed partially in Oregon, will also be shown by courtesy of E. H. Cameron, public relations man for Sears Roebuck and company, who sponsored the picture.

Friday morning will see the judging contests completed, and business sessions continued. Recreational activities, including bowling, basketball, softball, and swimming, and a tour of the Oregon Vocational school, will be featured Friday afternoon. The annual banquet at 6:00 will top off Friday activities. Saturday, April 10, new state officers will be elected and installed and various tours of the Klamath Basin area will be conducted. The big stunt and award night will conclude the convention Saturday evening.

Tourist Travel To Be Talked

PULLMAN, Wash., March 30 (AP) Two questions—how to get more tourists into the Pacific Northwest and what to do with them when they arrive—will attract representatives of four states to the first annual Pacific Northwest recreational conference here next week.

The two-day meeting, set for April 5-6, has been given official recognition with the governors of Washington, Oregon, Idaho and Montana to be represented.

Other delegates will include representatives of chambers of commerce, civic clubs, newspapers, radio stations, travel agencies, airlines, bus companies, hotels, resorts and other agencies aligned with the tourist business.

Two Washington State college professors—Maurice W. Lee, dean of the school of economics and business, and Donald Greenaway, a specialist in hotel administration—will preside.
