Zionists Plan Independent Jewish State

JERUSALEM, April 13 (AP)—The Zionist general council intends to proclaim an independent Jewish state in the Holy Land May 16, the day after the British mandate ends. The decision was made yesterday after an all-night session of the council at Tel Aviv. An internal authority may be set up which eventually would become the provisional government of the Jewish state.

Members also approved the long proposed military accord between Hagannah, the Jewish militia, and Irgun Zvai Leumi, Jewish underground group.

Council members adopted a resolution re-stating earlier announcements of the Jewish position on Palestine.

It said the Jews will oppose any plan to prevent or postpone setting up a Jewish state, rejected flatly any proposal to set up a trusteeship, and agreed recognition of the Jewish provisional council of government by the United Nations committee is necessary.

As leaders tried to work out a government program, Jewish and Arab forces continued fighting which has gone on since last fall. Jewish forces appeared to be in control of a 20-mile stretch of highway in the Judean hills. It is along this Tel Aviv-Jerusalem road that Arabs have blasted Jewish food convoys bound for hungry Jerusalem. The British army said a shipload of Jewish refugees without visas had been intercepted by the navy in Palestine coastal waters.

Another large food convoy from the coastal plain reached Jerusalem safely today.

Ice Foes Need All Seven Tilts

VANCOUVER, B. C., April 13 (AP)—Vancouver's Canucks and San Diego's Skyhawks may need all seven of the games available to decide the Pacific Coast Ice Hockey league championship.

The team to win four games takes the trophy. Three have been played, all with close scores. The Canucks are ahead 2-1 by virtue of last night's 7-5 defeat of the Skyhawks.

San Diego can tie it up by winning here Wednesday. Vancouver led 2-1 at the end of the second period. Then both teams erupted.

Lumber Prices Said Going Down

WASHINGTON, April 13 (AP)—Lumber prices apparently are "receding from their all-time highs," the commerce department said today.

It added that future prices will depend mostly on the extent of domestic construction and "the willingness or determination of lumber consumers to defer their use until prices have been readjusted."

The department's report said foreign needs under the European recovery program are "not expected to be greatly above the rate of United States exports during the middle of 1947." These averaged about 400,000,000 board feet a quarter.

Salmon Spawning Habit Study Slated

PORTLAND, Ore., April 13 (AP)—Pacific coast states plan an ocean-tagging program to aid in studies of the spawning habits of the silver-side and Chinook salmon.

Arnie J. Suomela, master fish warden of Oregon, reported the plan by which each state will tag 2000 adult salmon in the offshore fishery. It is sponsored by the Pacific marine fisheries commission.

He explained that movement of the fish in the ocean waters is still a puzzle to the experts.

Five More Mines Seen

ASTORIA, Ore., April 13 (AP)—Five more derelict mines turned up on the Oregon and Washington coasts Sunday, and a navy disposal officer headed down from Seattle to explode them.

The Point Adams coast guard station said 33 mines have washed ashore in the Northwest in the last 11 days.

Coast guardsmen issued a new warning to the public after two boys reported a mine they found north of Newport "was no good, because we tried to take the horns off."

Week-end crowds at Seaside watched one bob in the surf until a guard was placed around the explosive. Another was sighted below Cape Lookout and a fourth further south on the Oregon coast. The one off the Washington coast was near Neah bay.

Police Hunt For Hit-Run Driver

PORTLAND, April 13 (AP)—A broken headlight lens was a police clue Monday in the search for a light colored automobile that failed to stop Saturday night after fatally injuring a woman pedestrian.

Traffic officers William Arata and Don Chapin, who witnessed the accident, chased the motorist but lost the trail in a maze of Southeast streets taken by the motorist.

The victim was Mrs. Blanche Raab, 32. She was dead when admitted to a hospital. A husband survives.

Vote On School Districts Tied

NEHALEM, April 13 (AP)—A vote on a proposed consolidation of three high school districts has resulted in a tie vote here, but balloting in the two other districts—Wheeler and Garibaldi—has not been officially reported.

In a previous election of the plan, the two districts had approved the projected consolidation.

Man Takes Life In Motor Court

MILLS CITY, April 13 (AP)—Erie Fulgham, Dallas lumberman, was found dead in a motor court cabin here Saturday. The coroner's office said he died of self-inflicted shotgun wounds.

He had been on leave of absence from his work since December because of ill health. He was general superintendent of the Willamette Lumber company and Corvallis Lumber company mills.

California Lifts Power Restrictions

SAN FRANCISCO, April 13 (AP)—All electric power restrictions in Northern California were lifted Monday until June 1.

Whether they will be reimposed then will depend upon mountain snow and water conditions, said Emergency Power Director Robert P. O'Brien.

A power brownout was imposed more than a month ago because of an unprecedented winter drought and depletion of mountain hydroelectric water supplies. Since then, belated spring rains in the valleys and snow in the mountains have eased the situation.

Lifting of the restrictions was announced by O'Brien.

The order wipes out the 20 per cent power cuts and lighting regulations which had affected Northern California power consumers, particularly manufacturers and farmers.

PORTLAND, April 13 (AP)—The Oregon republican committee has elected James J. Richardson, former Multnomah Athletic club manager, as state treasurer.

B. W. Owens, Marion county chairman, was named to the state executive committee.

Demo Convention Plans Outlined

SEATTLE, April 13 (AP)—The largest single delegation to the state democratic convention will favor sending an uninstruced delegation to the national party assembly.

The King county convention, which will send 199 delegates to the state meet in Spokane, favored an uninstruced delegation despite commending President Truman in several resolutions.
