Coal Lack Cripples Steel Industry

NEW YORK, April 21 (AP)—Steel lost because of the coal miners' walkout will total more than 1,500,000 tons, the Iron Age, a trade publication, estimates.

The magazine said it had added 100,000 tons to an estimate made a

week ago due to slowness of the miners to return to work. Production this week, the Iron Age said, is 79 per cent of capacity, up 4.5 points from last week's revised rate of 74.5 per cent.

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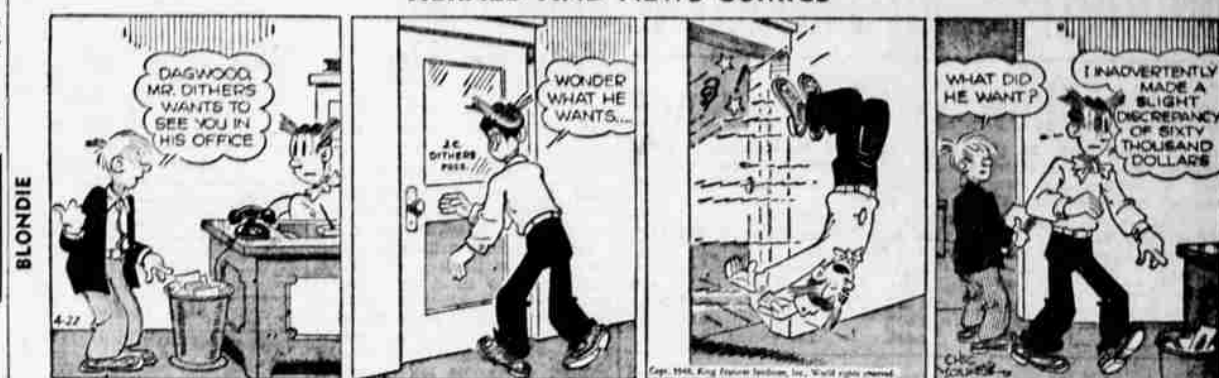
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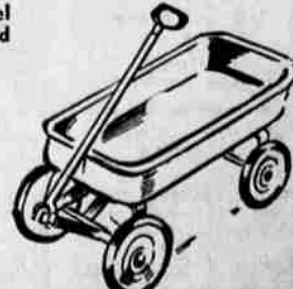
