Driver Burns Under Wreck

THE DALLES, May 3 (AP)—A young motorist was burned to death while pinned under a wrecked automobile east of here yesterday.

State police reported gasoline fumes of the car apparently were ignited by defective wiring or the flame of a highway warning flare set out by one of three Washington youths who assisted in an attempted rescue.

The victim, Philbert Meyer, 18, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fritz Meyer of Condon, Ore., was alive at the time fire broke out. He had spoken to his companions, Floyd Cook and Dave Adlard, both 16, Condon, just before the fire enveloped the wreckage.

Cook and Adlard suffered bruises and lacerations of the head.

Fire Chief Charles Roth Jr. said the rescue was attempted by Richard Rieber, Goldendale, Wash., Edgar Galbert, Washburn, Wash., and Jerry Portschy, Goldendale, who arrived at the scene after the accident.

Police said the car driven by Meyer had skidded in making a curve just east of here. It plunged into a ditch and overturned.

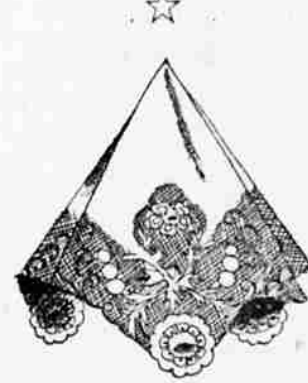
