

KU Seniors Ready For Graduation

Usual pre-graduation tremors are manifesting themselves around Klamath Union high school these days, with plans under way for commencement and other year-end activities.

Graduation exercises will take place Wednesday night, June 2, in Pelican court. Some 232 regular seniors and 21 war veterans, the vets graduating on special diplomas as per the specifications of the American Council of Education, will be given their sheepskins.

Bill Southwell and Cameron Stewart, valedictorian and salutatorian respectively, will deliver addresses. No other outside speakers will be on the program, with the exception of the usual talks by the school board chairman and those in charge of awards.

Baccalaureate Graduates will assemble in the KUHS auditorium Sunday evening, May 30, for baccalaureate services and rehearsal for that event has been slated for the morning of May 28. No speaker for the service has been announced as yet, but a committee of teachers and Principal Stanley Woodruff will announce the speaker soon.

Classes for the main student body will wind up activities on June 4, but seniors will end classwork a week earlier, on May 24. They will take exams from the 24th until the 27th, but rehearsals and final preparations will take up the extra week of "free time."

Other senior activities such as the senior banquet, junior-senior prom and senior skip-day and hick day are being planned, along with the reception which will be held for graduates and their parents in the girls' gym following commencement exercises June 2.

TREES PLANTED
CORVALLIS, May 11 (AP)—More than 350,000 two-year-old trees have been planted in the Siuslaw national forest since November, Forest Supervisor F. W. Furst said Monday. Approximately 70 per cent of the trees were Douglas fir, planted in areas of cutting and slash burning.

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Air Force To Launch Search

McCHORD FIELD, May 11 (AP)—Air force officials said Monday it was believed two army men, missing since April 17 in a private plane, had crashed in the mountains between Ellensburg and Seattle.

The men, Paul R. Jackson and William S. Burns of Seattle, were flying west from Spokane. They were last checked at the Ellensburg field. The civil aeronautics administration has contacted all airports in the area without locating the men.

Court Order Bans Mass Picketing

SEATTLE, May 11 (AP)—A court order banned mass picketing today at the strike-bound Boeing Airplane company.

The temporary restraining order was obtained by the company last night. It limits the striking Aeronautical Mechanics union (Ind) to not more than five pickets before any plant entrance.

The surprise move followed union efforts to strengthen picket lines in support of its 20-day-old walkout.

The order was issued by Superior Judge Roger J. Meakin shortly after 10 p. m.

Both the AMU and the parent International Association of Machinists were given until 10 a. m. Thursday to show cause why the restrainer should not be made permanent.

Boeing spokesmen said the order was requested "to limit the union to peaceful picketing."

Union officials were not immediately available for comment. The company charged in its complaint that the reinforced pickets "bumped, pushed and kicked" workers seeking to pass the lines yesterday. It said pickets "shouted obscene, insulting and abusive words . . . threatened physical violence and grave bodily injury . . . threatened to overturn automobiles . . . and formed chain picket lines to prevent vehicular traffic."

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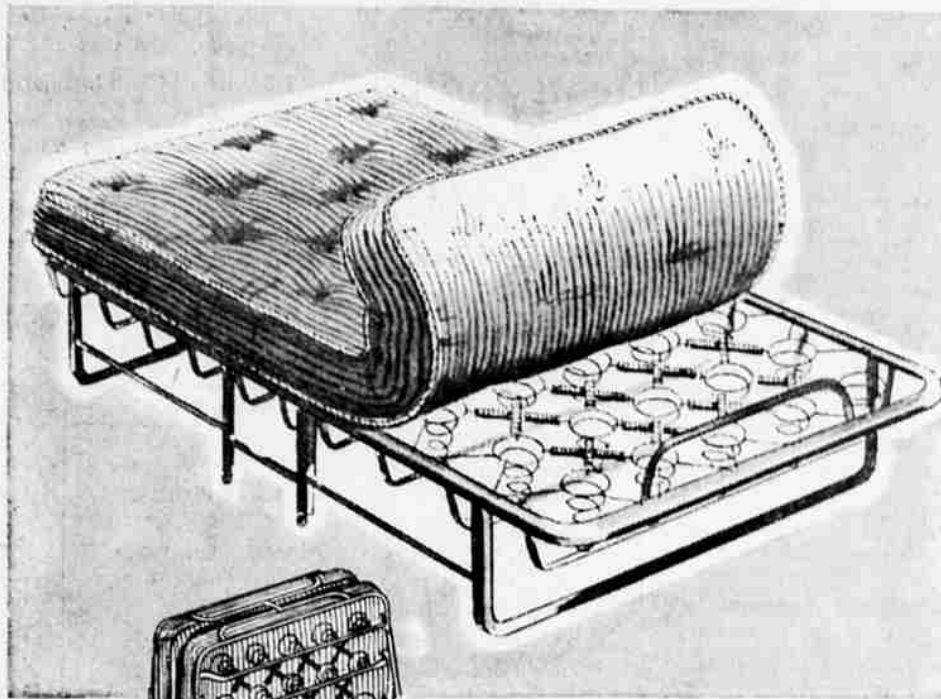
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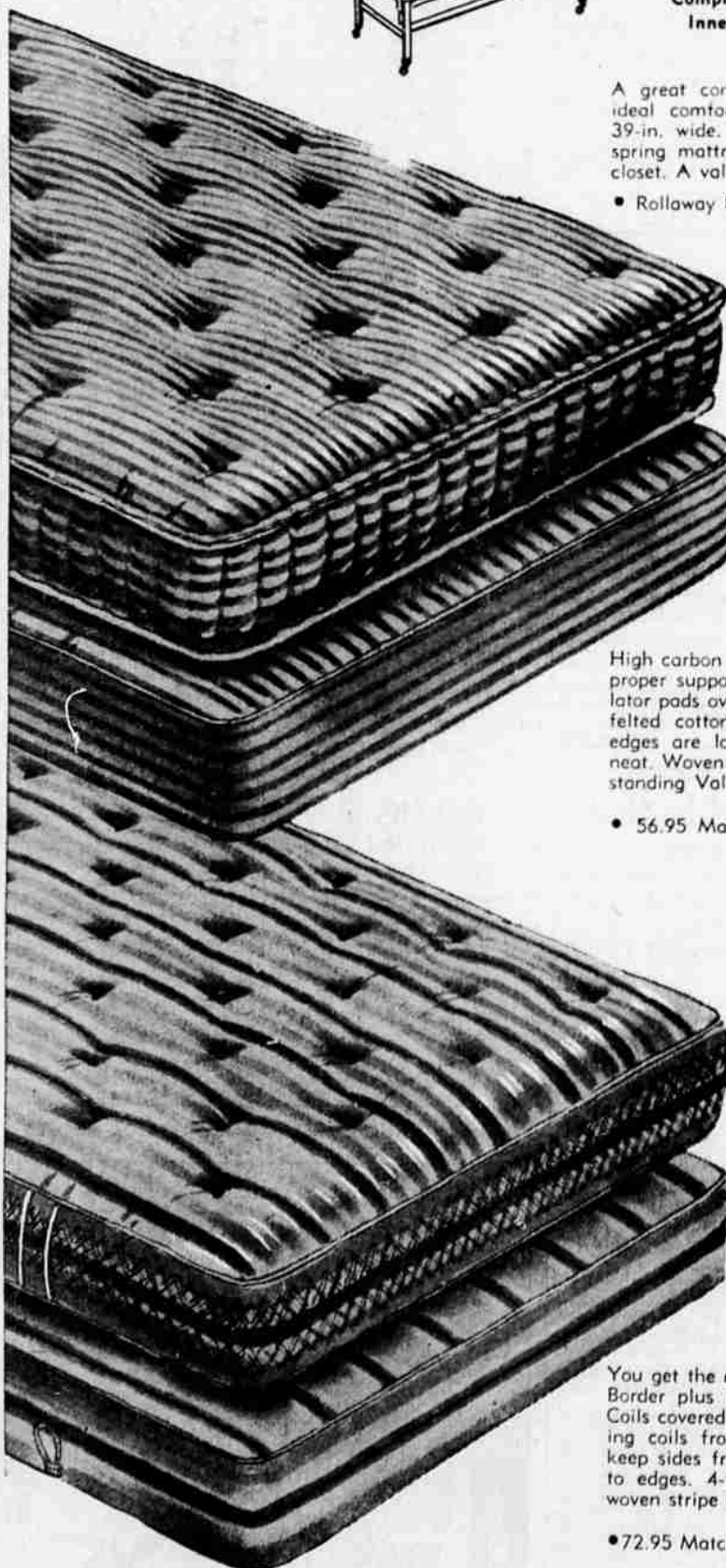
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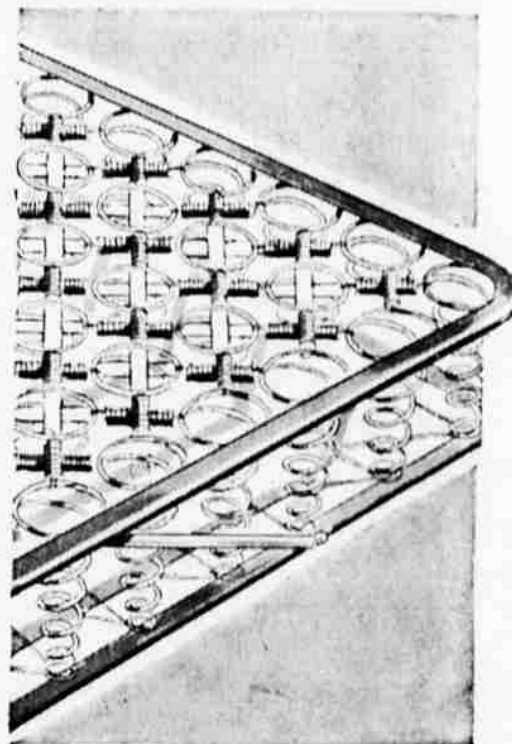
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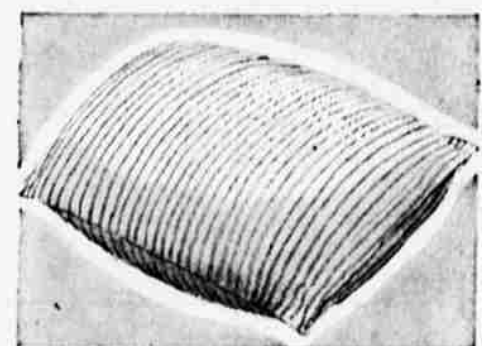


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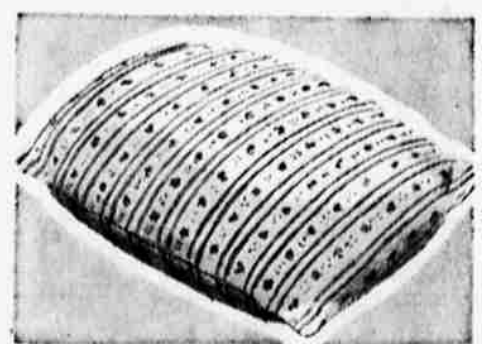


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
