This is Clean-Up Month in Klamath Falls, and as his contribution to the effort, Ray Grams of this city took the accompanying pictures in the business district. The scenes shown are familiar to all Klamath people, and graphically illustrate the why of a Clean-Up month, which was started by Klamath Union high school students. Students To Aid City In Clean-Up

A letter summing up their ideas of what ought to be done to make Klamath Falls a cleaner city is being prepared by Klamath Union high school students and will be sent to the city council. This will wind up the students' part in the campaign.

Ideas proposed by the youngsters include:

1. More trash containers in the business district.
2. Restrict overnight parking to make possible more effective street sweeping at night.
3. Improve garbage pick-up in town.
4. Eliminate piling of loose rubbish or rubbish in open containers back of business houses.
5. Better policing.

Arabs Rip Into Jewish Villages

TEL AVIV, Palestine, May 14 (AP) Haganah said Thursday that Arabs had attacked a group of Jewish settlements about Kfar Etzion, had entered Kfar Etzion and that Jewish casualties were heavy.

Kfar Etzion and its surrounding settlements are south of Bethlehem. The Jewish militia said the settlements "have been split by an Arab attack" and that "Arab legion forces have penetrated into Kfar Etzion itself."

"Great numbers of our people have been killed and wounded," the Haganah announcement said.

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The three largest cities in Palestine are Jerusalem, Tel Aviv and Haifa. Palestine, lacking natural harbors in ancient times, had no sea trade before modern harbors were built.



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
